EARLY LEGISLATORS

ONTARIO'S FIRST LAW MAKERS HAD NO EASY TASK.

First Bye-Election Was Because Quaker Refused Oath of Office—Marriage Relation and Negro Slavery Were Bible Problems.

It was at Kingston that John Graves Simcoe, the first lieutenant-governor of Upper Canada, in the early part of the summer of 1792 organized the first government of that province.

In due time the elections were held, when sixteen members were returned—the full number provided by the constitutional act.
