BRITISH CLUBS AT PRINCETON. University Students Hailing From Canada and Old Land Unite.

The Canadian students of Princeton University and of the Theological Seminary have organized themselves into a club, called the Canadian Club, of Princeton, New Jersey, which meets on the second Saturday evening of every month.

At the last regular meeting of the club, to which all the students in Princeton from universities in various parts of the British empire were invited, it was decided unanimously to form a British Club, and the following representative committee was appointed to draft a constitution and nominate officers: N. O. White, Ontario; New Zealand, chairman; S. O. Burns, B.A., Queen's, Canada; A. O. Hayes, B.A., McGill, Canada; J. McCann, B.A., Trinity College, Dublin; B. B. Keet, B.A., South African College, Cape Town.

SCOTTISH EARTHQUAKE. Burglaries at Banks Are Reported Among Other Results.

A severe shock of earthquake was felt late the other night throughout the Glasgow district. It was without parallel in Western Scotland with in living memory.

In Govan many tenants rushed from their homes, and fully half an hour elapsed before they were reassured. In Glasgow, dishes were thrown from shelves, chairs were moved, glasses rattled, windows shook, and bells rang. No personal injuries, however, were sustained.

It is a curious coincidence that several shocks of earthquake, in remote parts of the world, have, during the past two or three days, been registered by recording instruments in Glasgow.
