FOR NEEDED IMPROVEMENTS TO VICTORIA PARK. Lights and Walks Badly Needed—

Light and walks badly needed—criticism of ornamentation of lower parks until Victoria receives attention.

Victoria park, apart from the usual grass cutting, tree-fripping and flowers, which could not very well be denied, received half a dozen loads of manure to repair its walks, and the material remained in a heap for three months before being spread.

Another matter puzzling to residents of this part of the city is the extension of Mack street. Over a year ago a by-law was passed providing for this, but since the "nothing doing" sign has been hanging out.
