Not quite so pronounced as the trouser skirt, but equally eccentric in conception, is the narrow, straight skirt, cut out in a triangle over one foot. This wedge-shaped section is usually taken out just to the left of the centre-front so that the left foot and instep are plainly visible, and in order that the eccentricity of the skirt may not be overlooked, the triangular opening is carefully bordered with trimming and is sometimes flanked by bright buttons. Narrow velvet skirts of the late winter have had this wedgeshaped opening at the bottom, a band of fur running around the lower edge of the skirt and up around the triangle at one side of the front. 
