SUFFERING IN MEXICO.

Women and Children Roam in Search of Food.

El Paso, Texas, March 15.—Stories of suffering throughout Northern Mexico continue to reach here. A courier who walked from a point north of the city of Chihuahua reported that famine faced the 25,000 inhabitants of that place.

Hundreds of women fearing that the siege of the city which already has continued for eight days, will soon cause starvation, have secured permission from the authorities to leave, and bands of women, accompanied by their children, are now roaming the country.

JOHN SOUTHERN STRIKERS. Fight With Firemen and Dynamite is Used.

Lexington, Ky., March 15.—Ten men have been shot to death by striking firemen on the Cincinnati-Chattanooga division of the Queen & Crescent railway and their sympathizers and numerous others have been wounded or assaulted since the strike began several days ago, on account of the employment of negro firemen.

The mountaineers in the district from Somerset, Ky., to a considerable distance south of the Tennessee line have joined with the strikers.

Many pounds of dynamite are said to have been found on the tracks by the trackwalkers on the affected lines and it is said threats have been made to dynamite the bridges on the line, but the wire communication has been cut off in the district around King's Mountain and southward and trains seldom come through.
