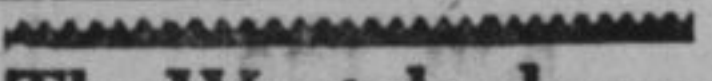

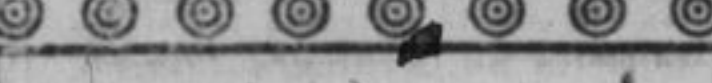

GRAFT FROM DEAD

TO LIVING BODIES BY GERMAN SURGEONS.

Anatomical Parts Taken From Dead Bodies Receive New Life and Natural Articulation.

Berlin, May 4.—After American surgeons had begun to graft skin, muscles and bones from animals on human bodies German surgeons undertook to implant parts taken from dead bodies into living men. Dr. Kautz, professor of the University of Breslau, explained in a wounded man a ball and socket joint and part of the femur with corresponding parts taken from a body with success.

The patient died a few months later of apoplexy and Professor Kautz was thus able by means of post-mortem examination to show in the surgical congress anatomical pieces proving that the part really taken from the dead body had received new life and attained natural articulation.

Another patient operated on in the same way presented himself a year after the operation.

The surprising success of this new method of grafting parts of dead bodies was surpassed by a demonstration by Professor Lexer, of the University of Jena, the inventor and propagator of new transplantation methods. He presented a female patient who had attempted suicide by drinking sulphuric acid and seriously injured the oesophagus. Professor Lexer formed out of a piece of the intestine and external skin a new oesophagus, reaching from the stomach to the throat.

The assembly, which was composed of the most famous German surgeons, was able to convince itself that the patient not only eats and drinks, but that the new oesophagus fulfils all the natural functions.

WHERE GOLD ACCUMULATES.

Russia Surpasses France, and Italy Ranks Third.

In ten years Russia has added 310 million dollars to its stock of gold, raising the total in the treasury to 791 millions. Even France has been passed in the contest of accumulation. In ten years the Bank of France has increased its supply of the metal by 259 millions, raising the total to 678 millions.

One year ago Russia held less than France, but in the interval the former has gained 66 millions, while the latter has lost 63 millions. It may be learned with some surprise that Italy has ranked third as an accumulator of gold since 1900, its stock holding rise from 77 millions to 191 millions, a gain of 117 millions.

Germany has gained only a little of 5 millions, while the Bank of England's increase has averaged only 3 millions per annum, or less than 33 millions in all. Its gold supply today stands just 200 millions, which is exceeded not only by Russia and France, but by Austria-Hungary, and is only 5 millions above Germany's, and 7 millions above Italy's stock, while, of course, it is little more than half the amount held by the New York clearing house banks alone, to say nothing of the billion odd dollars that is retained in the United States treasury.

Twenty years ago France held only 264 millions, Germany 138 millions, England, 113 millions and Austria-Hungary, the insignificant total of 22 millions against 227 millions, to-day. In some of the New York clearing house banks and the treasury department have added 878,241,275 to their holdings in ten years.—Finance.
