IT SIMPLY FLIES. Thousand Island Craft Develops

This as Maximum. Washington, May 17.-In trials on the Potomac river here it is claimed that a new gasoline speed boat recently launched at Alexandria, Va., and owned by W. F. Harris, of the Thousand Islands, attained a maximum of forty-two miles an hour. This speed record was unofficial, but was faster-by seven miles than any water, craft ever before had made. The new boat is twenty-six feet long and has twin engines of six cylinders, each giving a horse power of 250. craft has not yet been named.
