SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS

AND PENSION WHO IS THE SOLE head of a family, or any one over 15 years old may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The land may appear in possession of the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any time under certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

For six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of 50 acres which he owns and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

The homesteader selects a homestead of good standing man pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price, \$2.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate 100 acres and erect a house worth \$100.00.
