(Continued from Page 1.) means. Midland likewise, and the dredging and improvements here, and in front of the new Tiffin elevator are only recent works.

Following these resolutions, A. B. Rufess, assistant chief engineer, referred the matter to Mr. Chapleau, the district engineer of the department of public works, and in March last he submitted his report dealing with the matters in detail, and in making his recommendations, submitted plans for the dredging required. His estimates to make a twenty-two-foot draft in our harbor, involves an expenditure within \$600,000. To carry on the work and complete it would require some five or six seasons.

The minister of public works promptly took up the matter on the report submitted, and the placing of the sum of \$50,000 in the estimates, is the best evidence that the government has decided on making Kingston a national harbor, and one that must add greatly to the prestige of the port and form a link in the chain of the great transportation route from Lakes to ocean.

The citizens of Kingston will certainly be pleased to hear of the success that has attended the efforts put forth by our delegations from the council, the board of trade, the Dominion Marine Association, and the Hon. Mr. Hart.

When this expenditure has reached millions, as it has, it is respectfully submitted, that having regard to the importance of Kingston as the harbor at which transhipment from lake to

MISSIONARIES, WHO ARE PHYSICIANS, RECEIVE GIFT OF CRAFT TO AID THEM IN THEIR LABORS.

NEW YORK, SEPT. 13.—INHABITANTS OF THE PROVINCE OF KAI-CHOW, ONE THOUSAND MILES IN THE INTERIOR OF CHINA, ARE SOON TO SEE AN AMERICAN MOTOR BOAT, THE FIRST CRAFT OF ITS KIND TO PLY THE WATERS OF THE YUEN RIVER.

DR.
