PUT NITRO-GLYCERINE BLASTING CARTRIDGES IN FIRE.

Awful Explosion Follows—Parts of Bodies Were Hurling in All Directions—One Ailights in Tree.

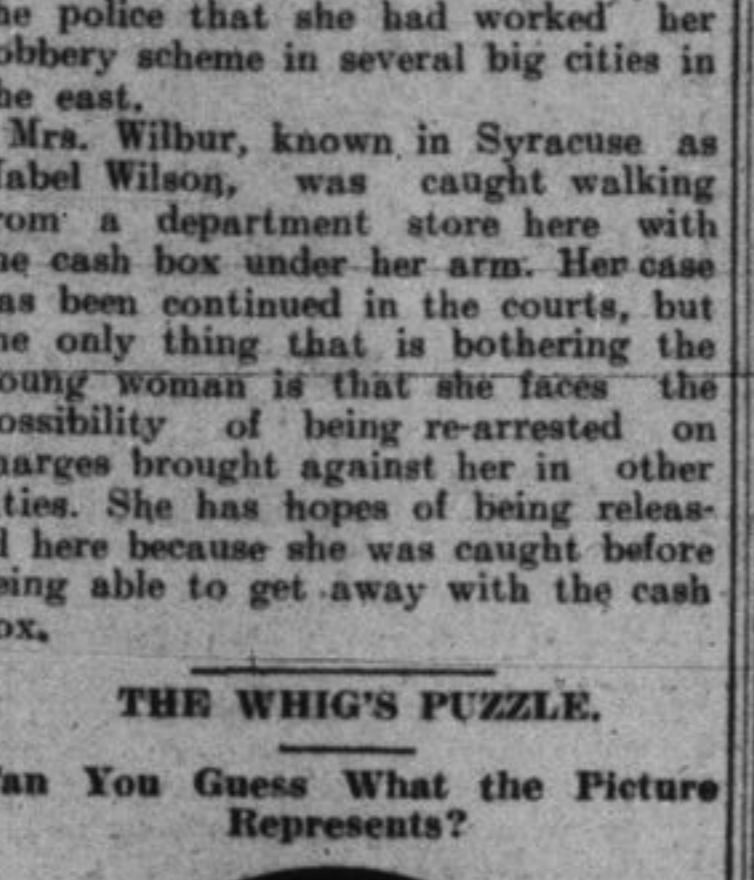
Rochester, N.Y., Nov. 17.—A boyish prank of throwing nitro-glycerine blasting cartridges into a bonfire they had built, yesterday, resulted in an explosion that instantly killed one boy and two companions died later at the general hospital.

The force of the explosion shattered windows within a radius of 500 feet. It is believed that the boys threw about 450 of the blasting cartridges into the fire.
