ANY PERSON WHO IS THE SOLE head of a family or any male over 14 years old may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency, on certain conditions. Mother, daughter, brother or sister.
