FUNCHAL, Madeira, Oct. 29.—Five hundred Americans outward bound on a cruise around the world gave Funchal the busiest Sunday that it has had in many a day. One half of the city, dressed in its best tab and tucker, hastened to the pier to serve on the self appointed reception committee.

It is to the British that Madeira owes much of what prosperity remains to it. Funchal is one of the mild climate places which the Englishman loves, first, because of its climate and, second, because of the profusion of beautiful flowers. And it is such a health giving spot that one wonders why Stevenson went far out into the Pacific in quest of a longer lease of life. Much that you see in Funchal may be found elsewhere in the world, but in its facilities for "rapid transit" it may claim to be unique. Ox carts are not uncommon in any part of the world, but where else may you ride over cobblestone streets in a canopied sled drawn by oxen. This is the vehicle of the lower town. The steam tramway of Funchal is merely for the convenience of the foreigner who wishes to ascend the mountain to a fine hotel that overlooks the city. And for the descent again you find the sled, but in a modified form. It may be called the "surface line," but the narrow, winding street that leads down from the hotel is better known as "the slide." It is built for two or three passengers, yet it requires two husky "motormen" to steer it around the curves by means of the ropes on either side. Whenever its locomotion becomes slow and painful one of the "motormen" draws forth a bag of grease and lays it under the runner—a crude method of lubrication, but it brings results. Taken all in all, Funchal is one of the most attractive and enjoyable of the island cities, and it is a great pity that only the Briton has discovered it.

LAND VACANT 60 YEARS. In Best Residential Section of St. Thomas. St. Thomas, Ont., Dec. 8.—For the last sixty years a piece of land situated in the best residential section of St. Thomas has been lying without buildings or tenants owing to the fact that a clear title could not be secured. The ownership of this property was decided out of court. The original owner, Rev. John McIntyre, emigrated to Australia some sixty years ago, having raised the money by placing a mortgage on his brother, the late Archibald McIntyre, of St. Thomas, who fenced the property and paid the taxes until his death, fifteen years ago. Since that time the taxes have been paid by his heirs.

Ancient Suit Settled. Frankfurt, Dec. 9.—What is said to be the oldest case in the courts, has just been settled here, four hundred years after it was instituted. The action grew out of the dispute between the Lebusser-Kietzer fishers and the Frankfort fishermen as to who had the right to fish in the Oder river. The trouble began in 1560 and the Lebusser fishermen showed where Duke Joachim I had first decided in their favor in that year. A second decision was awarded them in 1697, and now, in 1911, the imperial high court has again decided against the Frankfort fishermen.

Woman to be Beheaded. Chemnitz, Dec. 9.—Convicted of having poisoned her thirteen-year-old daughter, to obtain \$5,000 insurance, Magdalena Voight, is awaiting the sword of the executioner. Germany still adheres to the old method of beheading, but instead of an axe, a long sharp sword is used. It has been some time since a woman has been executed in Germany.
