SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS.

ANY PERSON WHO IS THE SOLE head of a family or any male over 18 years of age may, in any part of the section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, or the Northwest Territories, apply to the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the district in which the land is situated. The applicant must appear in person at the office of the Agency or Sub-Agency, or by proxy, if he is unable to do so, and must be accompanied by a witness who is a resident of the district. The applicant must be a Canadian citizen, or the son of a Canadian citizen, or the son of a British subject, or the son of a person who has been naturalized in Canada. The applicant must be at least 18 years of age, and must be of sound mind and of legal age. The applicant must be a resident of the district in which the land is situated, or must have been a resident of the district for a period of six months immediately preceding the date of his application. THE KING'S TRAIN.

Acme of Safety and Comfort Are Found in His Majesty's Special.

When King George travels by railway, he does so in remarkable safety and comfort. The royal train represents the acme of the railway builder's art. With their silver-mounted bedsteads, and easy chairs, and window draperies, it is difficult to realize that the apartments are sections of a railway carriage, while the running is so smooth and so quiet that the train is almost silent. The various royal saloons used on different lines are built and owned by the respective companies, the royal party paying their fares like any other passenger. The program of running having been completed, a most interesting and complicated part of railway organization begins. Each company has a chart or "visualized time-table," as it has been called. This is divided vertically into twenty-four equal spaces, one for every hour of the day, and each hour is further subdivided into minutes, the half-hour, quarter-hour, and five-minute intervals being denoted by darker lines. This time-scale is then divided horizontally into a distance-scale, the stations and junctions being shown on the left-hand margin in their relative positions.

On the chart the running of the trains is indicated by means of lines drawn from point to point across the scale, and colored to show the class of traffic—a red line denotes an express train, a blue line a passenger train, and a green line a freight train. The course of the royal train is set down on this wonderful traffic chart, and whenever the line cuts another, that other must be delayed, and the purple track allowed to proceed through the gap in safety. A special working timetable is next prepared, and copies of it are distributed to the officials concerned along the entire route. The private detective department of the palace also advises the police authorities of the districts through which the train will pass of the hours of running, so that additional protection may be provided at different places.
