A CRECHE IS NEEDED

TO AID THE WORKING MOTHERS OF KINGSTON. Children's Aid Society Will Appeal to the Philanthropic and Benevolent Citizens.

That the Children's Aid Society is thoroughly seized of the imperative need of a creche to serve as a day shelter for children whose mothers, by having to go from home to earn their living, are compelled to leave them at home without adult supervision; and that this society hereby authorizes its agent, J. C. McConachie, to take steps to secure the co-operation of benevolent, philanthropic citizens in this arduous matter.

Another important matter dealt with at the meeting was that of a shelter. This is needed to accommodate children between the ages of twelve and fifteen, while the agent is investigating their cases and providing for their future.
