The well-kept secret came out when a deputation of publishers and newspaper editors waited upon Home Secretary McKenna to protest against the circulation of poisonous prints.

The Home Secretary promised a more rigorous enforcement of the present law in regard to the suppression of demoralizing literature, and expressed the hope that the bill which had been drafted to carry out the recommendations of the Joint Select Committee on this subject would shortly become law.
