Owing to our efforts, and when we whole Jewish community and not in any personal sense, clause 2 of the bill was struck out in toto, and clause 3 of the bill was amended by striking out the words "national and undenominational in its character and management.

Owing to the force of public opinion which is certainly against the establishment of any test oath in a univer sity, the promoters of the bill decided to amend clause 19, thereby striking out the provisions requiring the test oath, only requiring that the professors of the university should be gentle men of Christian character, and that the university shall continue distinctly Christian.

By doing so, and by declaring pub liely that the words "Christian character" did not necessarily mean a belief in Christianity, they hoped placate public opinion.

This amendment we discussed last week, and declared that it was unac ceptable to us and that so long a any religious qualification was attach ed to the university, we objected to it being called a national university. The amendment made by the promoters of the bill was accepted by par liament without, however, repealing the previous amendments made.

MEXICAN SOIL INVIOLABLE Foreign Country Can Never Acquire

New York, April 12 .- It is impossible and always will be, for any foreign country to purchase Magedalena Bay property, according to a statement by Manuel L. Lujan, commissioner to the United States from General Pascual Orozco, leader of the revolutionary army in Mexico. The laws of Mexico forbid the selling of any part of the national domain be said. "The lavs on this subject in Mexico only diller understand them," Mr. Lujan explained, "in that those of Mexico are carefully designed to prohibit granting to any foreign government of one rights whatever in respect to the soil of Mexico. The Mexican law, however, goes further than your law innsmuch as it prohibits the disposition, by the federa! povernment, of any land within ! the zones of a certain width adjoining the aides of seas, have and navigable By threats and persussion they tried waters which are reserved for coast
