When Capt. E. J. Smith, commander of the ill-fated Titanic, went down to death with that vessel and its priceless cargo of lives last Monday morning, one more name was added to the long roll of marine heroes who have subscribed to the unwritten law of life and death.

Standing on the bridge at the mighty pile of steel and iron sank to its final cradle, the awful moments before the water closed over him gave him plenty of time to realize that his career of almost half a century had reached a fitting close.

Next to the honest stability of the Titanic the passengers put most of their confidence in Captain Smith, a man of the widest possible experience in handling giant vessels, a man who had weathered the ocean storms of forty-three years.

Strange as it may seem there are many men who envy him his tragic end. These are men who formerly commanded ocean steamships or large vessels of some sort and who forfeited their master certificates for some error of judgment.

British sailor is that Vice Admiral Tryon saluted the colors just as the swirling waters shut out his form forever. He was one of the prominent figures of the British navy and his death caused profound regret throughout Europe.

One of the greatest disasters of recent years is the sinking of the Norge, a Danish emigrant steamship, on Wednesday, June 29th, 1904. Of the 300 passengers only 100 were saved when the vessel went to the bottom a short time after going to pieces on the Rockall rocks in the North Atlantic.
