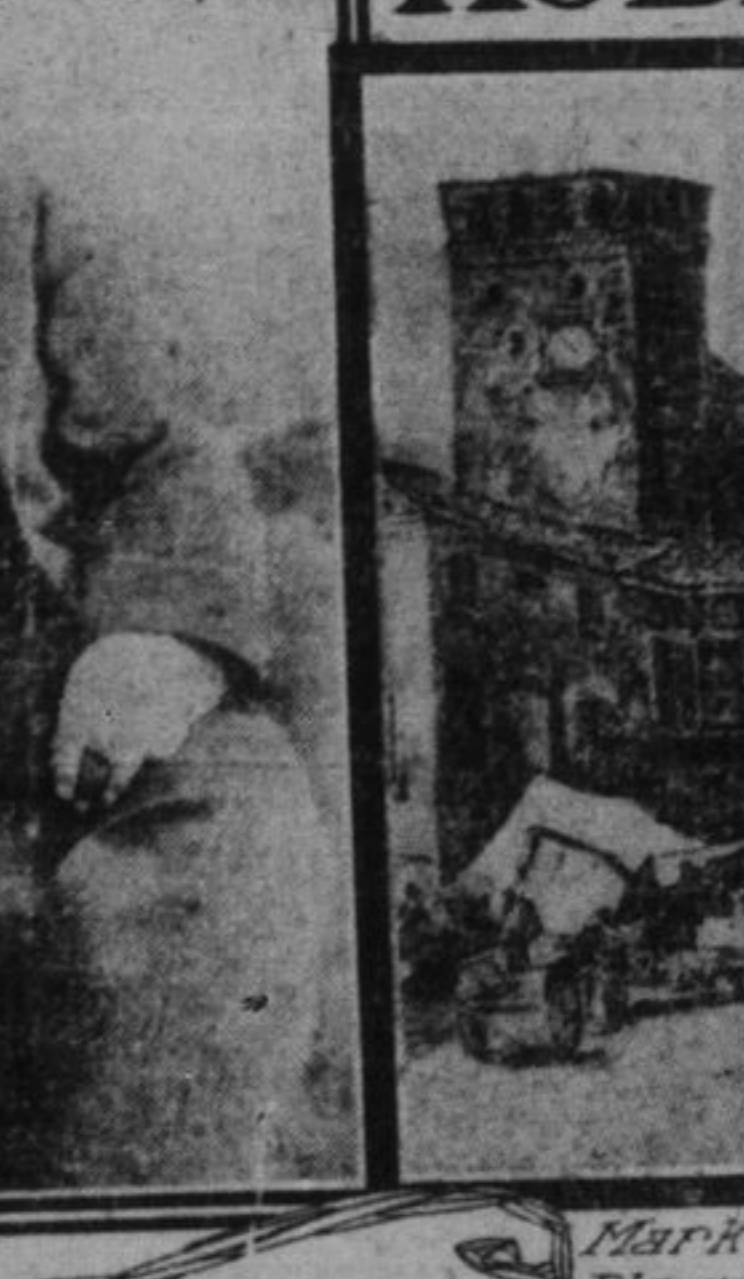

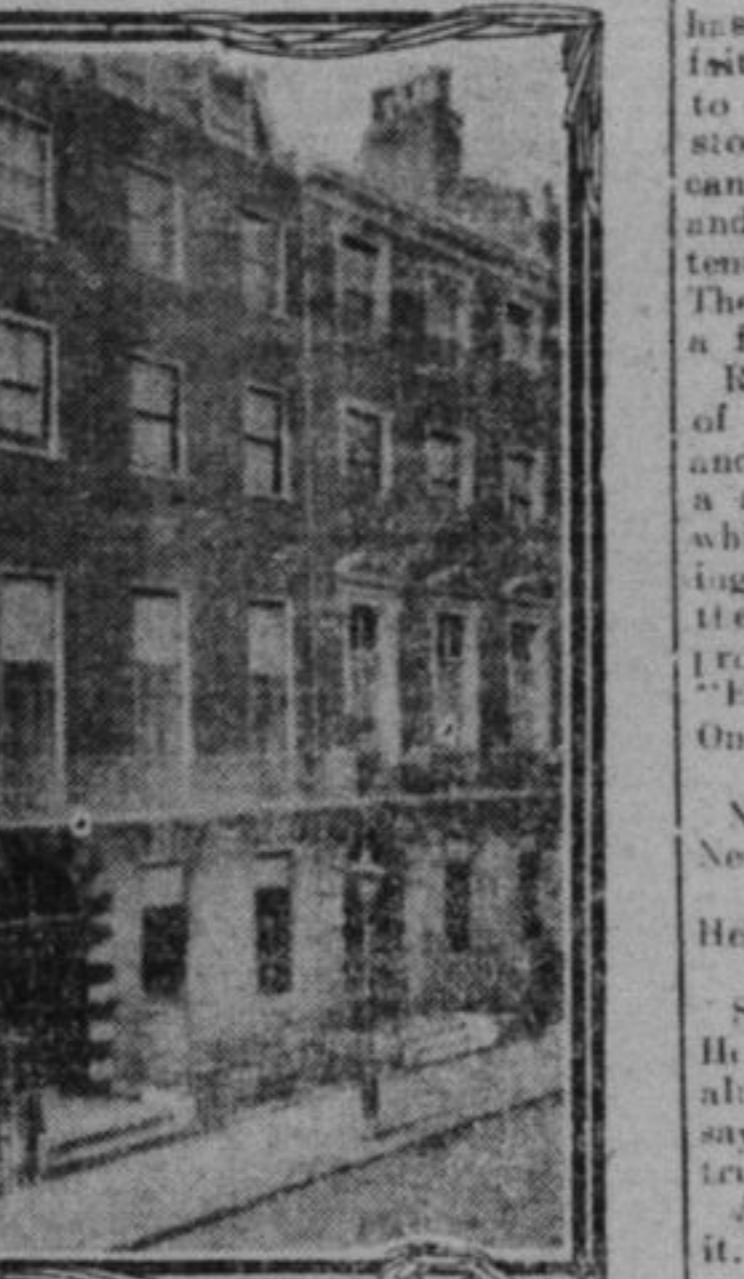
When Robert Browning's "Sordello" was published in 1810, it was the first line of the poem that may bear Sordello's story told...



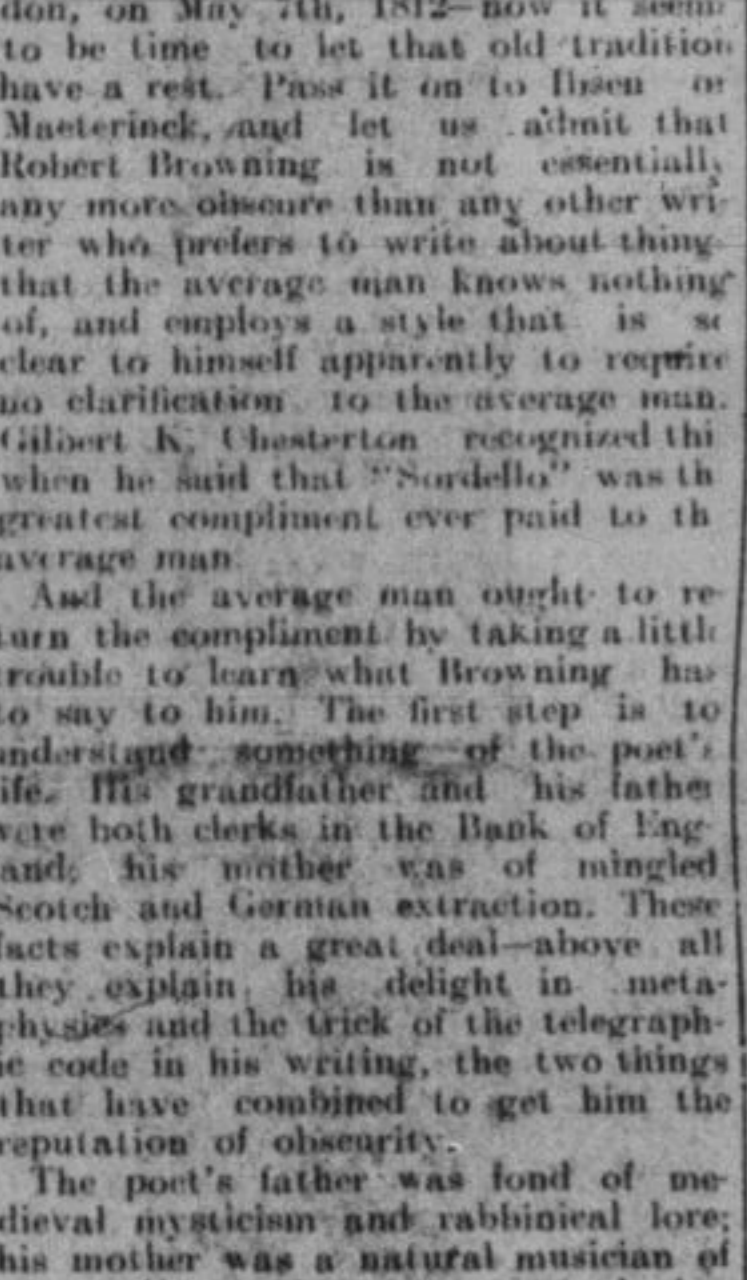
