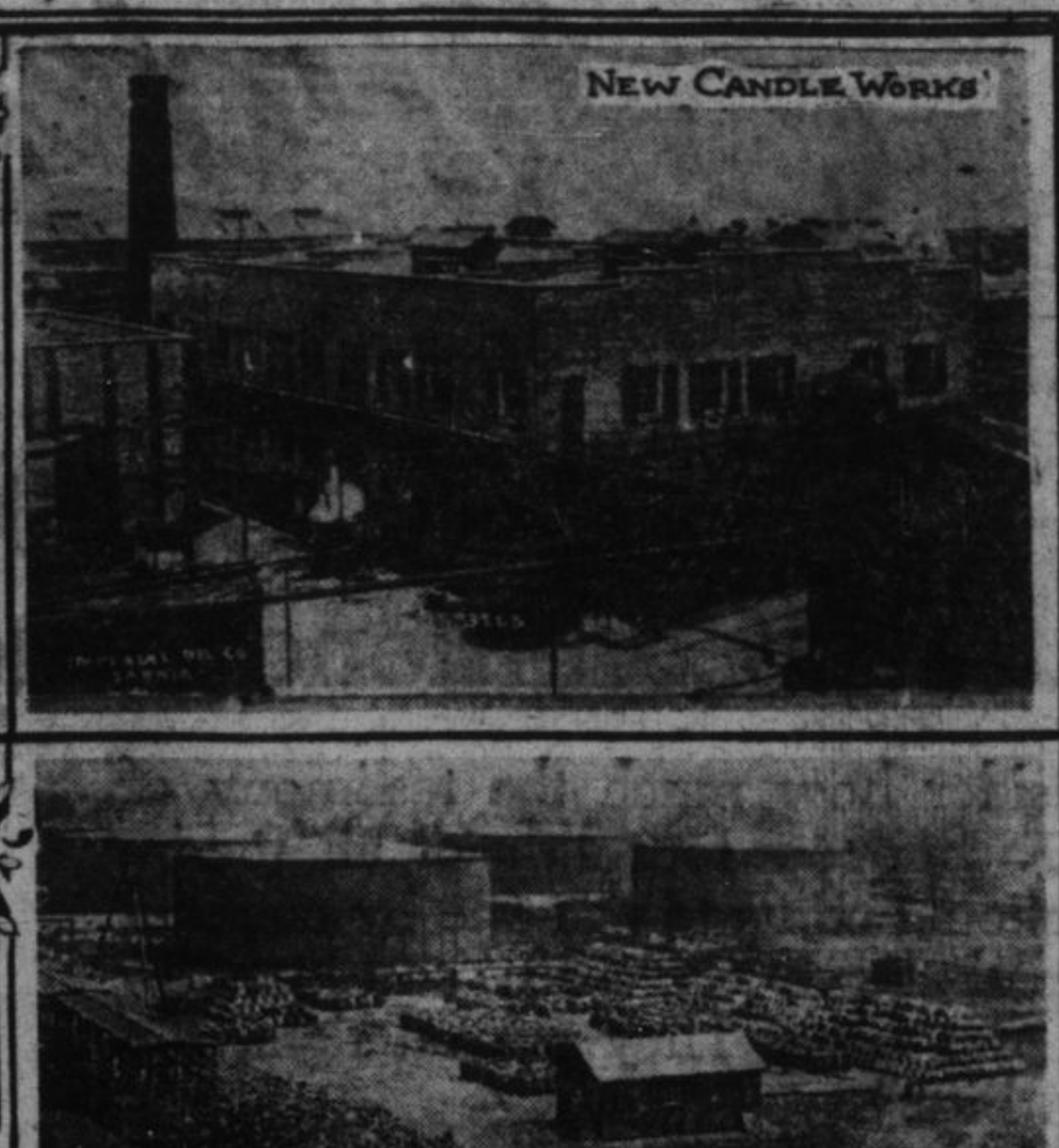
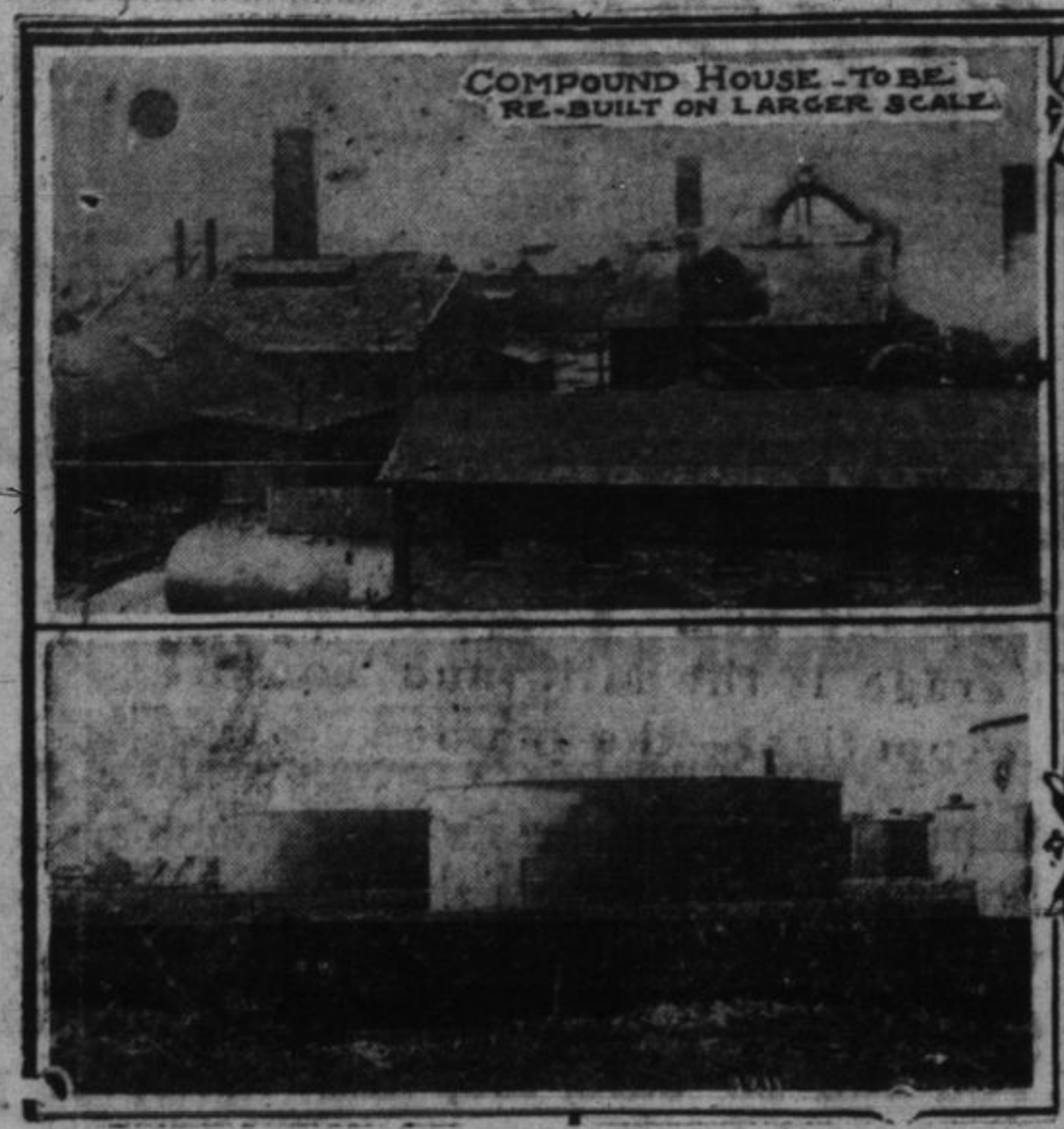

THE STANDARD OIL OCTUPUS GETTING ITS STRANGLE HOLD IN CANADA.



There has been a good deal of excitement in Sarnia, Ont., recently over the extensive additions being built to the plant of the Imperial Oil Company, a subsidiary concern of the Standard Oil Co. at that place. The story goes that the headquarters of the Standard Oil, being driven out of the United States by the new trust laws, will take up their abode in Sarnia. Certainly the Standard Oil is transferring three hundred office hands and nearly one thousand warehousemen to the small Canadian town, and is building structures to match. The lower picture shows one of the oil tanks, the largest west of Toronto, and probably the largest in Canada, but the Toronto writer declines to admit it. On the other side is seen big piles of oil barrels waiting to be refilled.

SMALL BOY ASKS \$1,025.
 Youth's Claim Against Animal Dealer Taken to Court.
 Cincinnati, May 28.—The bite of a monkey is given as the basis of a suit for \$1,025, filed in the superior court by Robert Ryan, thirteen years old, against Clara Hallogh, who keeps bird and animal store. Mrs. Kate Ryan, the boy's mother, appears in the suit as the "next friend" and plaintiff.
 It is alleged that on March 28th the boy was in the store when the monkey, which it was asserted, was permitted to run loose, bit him on the hand. The complainant says that instead of calling a doctor, the employees of the place treated the wound with vinegar.

WOMAN PAST FIFTY.
 Men Say Her Greatest Intellectual Growth Comes Then.
 Careful studies of the histories of men and women, their growth and development, extending over a long period of years, reveals some facts not recognized in the literature of the day, writes a physician in the Dietetic and Hygienic Gazette. A man and a woman, both college graduates, married at the age of twenty-five years. They both possessed culture and training above the average and were in excellent health.
 During the first twenty-five years of their married life he attained great eminence and did fine intellectual work. Then he became a mental invalid and remained at a standstill, without any special cause. During this time his wife had given all her attention and time to the care and education of her children and domestic duties, and while regarded as a very strong woman, seemed not to have risen above the level of her surroundings.
 Then suddenly she realized her husband's decline and entered into the work he was engaged in, and showed rare intellectual vigor and power, and in a very short time attained a reputation. This continued until her death. Her husband, in the meantime, failed to keep up his previous reputation and gradually declined, although he was not in ill-health. His intellectual work was over, but her's began when he stopped and went on to great heights.
 Thus in almost every community there are women not recognized as anything more than the average in intellectual attainments and wisdom, who turn out vigorous, strong thinkers and become great powers in the community.
 Joseph Cook said: "The most intellectual audiences I have ever addressed were women past fifty years of age. I have found them most appreciative and critical, and when I have asked for questions to bring out further explanations of the subject their wisdom has astonished me, as well as their clear judgment of knowledge and breadth of judgment."
 The late Professor Shaler affirmed that all things being equal and with a degree of average health, the real intellectual growth of women is more rapid after fifty years of age and from then on to seventy than in men.
 Usually men at about fifty years of age begin to decline in productive, literary or constructive work. The rest of life is spent in gathering up and perfecting work that has been outlined before. In women it is just the opposite. Many men who live rationally and carefully exhibit no halt in intellectual growth until after seventy. The best work of life is done in the last fifteen or twenty years.
 In women it may be stated as a rule that their highest attainments begin and go on after fifty. The term "grand old man" should more literally include the woman, who is the best illustration of all that is broad and strong.
