The Watertown baseball club is negotiating with several teams for a game there Sunday. The team most likely to play is the Thousand Island Park outfit, made up of college players.

With a view of lengthening the hockey season of four weeks, there is a possibility that the Montreal Arena will be sold by its present owners, and may be created into an artificial ice rink.

The Varsity old boys and present boys will open the rugby season at Varsity stadium on Saturday, Sept. 28th. Hugh Ball is looking after the Old Boys, and the champion team of 1909 will be in line.

**MADE A PURCHASE.**

Clearing House for Cars Used by G.T.R. Company.

Chicago, Aug. 15.—In the development of a general plan for growth along the lines of the "city beautiful" the purchase has been announced of the Chicago Union Transfer Co., known as the Chicago Clearing Yards by the Chicago and Western Indiana Railroad Co., a terminal company. This "clearing house for cars" will be used by the Grand Trunk railway as well as a number of other roads, including the Wabash, Erie, Chicago, Indianapolis & Louisville, Chicago & Eastern Illinois, Alhison, Topoka & Santa Fe, Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific, Illinois Central, Pennsylvania, Chicago, Burlington & Quincy, Minneapolis, St. Paul & Sault Ste. Marie, Chesapeake & Ohio, and the Pere Marquette. The clearing yards now comprise about 160 miles of track and it is intended to increase this to 600 or 700 miles. The property will be used by the above roads for the exchange of cars substantially in the same manner as the bank's exchange house so as to expedite traffic and relieve congested districts of the city. The amount has not been made public but it is said to have been several million dollars.
