BACK FROM AUSTRALIA

PRINCIPAL GORDON GIVES THE WHIG HIS IMPRESSIONS

Principal Gordon, after a delightful trip, has returned from Australia and is already plunged into his papers busy with the problems which go hand in hand with the opening of the university session. The trip has given him just what he sought—a complete rest. The isolation of the three weeks' trip from Vancouver to Australia was a splendid chance to get away from business and correspondence. Principal Gordon visited mainly New Zealand, New South Wales and Queensland. In conversation with the Whig he gave some interesting observations of his trip. In referring to the educational conditions, Principal Gordon said they were much the same as ours, although he thought not superior. Sydney is the largest city in Australia and they have a splendid university there. They deal with much the same lines of education

in machinery and implements. Principal Gordon spoke very favorably of a reciprocity agreement between the two countries, which is now under consideration.

THE LATE MRS. SAVARY.

Bishop of Fredericton Made Feeling Reference to Her Death.

At St. James' church, on Sunday morning, Right Rev. the Bishop of Fredericton, N.B., made a feeling reference to the death of Mrs. Savary, wife of the vicar of the church, whose death occurred very suddenly on Saturday morning, and brought sadness to the members of the congregation, by whom she was loved.

"I have been speaking to you this morning under a shadow of sadness," said the bishop. "The life of one who was ever dear to you has passed away, and some of you are asking the question, Why? You are wondering why it should be so, but there is a reason. God does not do anything without a reason and his reason is always love. You must not judge God's character by His conduct, but judge His conduct by His character. God has opened a ministry for you. God wants you to work with Him for the one great aim—the extension of His kingdom. Draw close to your pastor and work with him, give him your sympathy and help."

Funeral on Monday.

The funeral service for the late Mrs. T. W. Savary was said in St. James' church, on Monday afternoon, the building being filled with citizens and friends of the deceased wife of the vicar of the parish. The Lord Bishops of Montreal and Fredericton, Farthing and Richardson respectively, with Dean Bidwell, conducted the service and the choir was in attendance. "Nearer, My God to Thee," was one of the hymns sung.

The mourners were the deceased husband, Rev. T. W. Savary, E. Neve, of Westmont, Montreal, and uncles of Mrs. Savary, and Archdeacon Macmorine, rector of the parish. TWO BISHOPS PREACHED

AT SUNDAY SERVICES IN ANGLICAN CHURCHES.

Bishop of Fredericton Spoke on Spiritual Dependency—Bishop of Montreal's Theme Was "Putting on Christ."

The Right Reverend Dr. Richardson, Bishop of Fredericton, N.B., preached in St. James' church, on Sunday morning, and delivered a most impressive sermon. He dwelt on the question of spiritual dependency and of the times of depression which came to people—when their hearts were filled with despair, and they would ask the

question as to whether the religious life was worth while, and whether it really did mean anything. In spite of the faith some had they would see shadows instead of the sunshine.

The bishop pointed out, in an interesting manner, how temperament was born in a person, but it was not so with character. A person made his own character; it was the product of personality. When one would see these shadows when they should see sunshine, it was due to their temperament, and they were not responsible for it.

The text chosen for the sermon was Psalms LIII, 11: "Why art thou cast down, O my soul? And why art thou disquieted within me; hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him who is the high of my countenance, in and my God."

The Right Rev. Dr. Farthing, Lord Bishop of Montreal, preached in St. George's cathedral, on Sunday morning in the pulpit from which so many of his forceful sermons were delivered when he was dean of Ontario. His lordship earnestly impressed upon his hearers "putting on Christ," sharing his life, and having a clear conception of what that really means. The text was from Galatians III, 27: "For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ."

Bishop Farthing pointed out the need of the world for Christ. The newspapers are a daily revelation of the powers of evil, and the power of God must be revealed by his people, through Jesus Christ. As we are baptized into Christ, we are branches grafted into the vine, and share not only the humanity
