Deceased's wife died on Sept. 1st, 1911, and two sons, living in South Dakota, survive. They are engaged in the jewelry business. They were notified of their father's death on Thursday night.

The late Mr. Lundin was born in Sweden and came to Kingston a few years ago. The family resided on James street. After their mother's death the two boys left for South Dakota.
