bales. The cotton is brought from Co., Brockville, Ont. the southern states, mainly Texas and the Mississippi district. The bales are unpacked here, and fed into a blowing carrier system which of about 40 yards in length. The cotton passes through three of these processes and is then taken to the card room where it passes over revolving flat cards of which there are forty in number. These machines comb out the cotton, and it comes out in a filmy web which is concentrated into a large yarn called a sliver. This is fed from cylinders into drawing machines six strands at a time. The strands are reduced into one this process goes on through three ma-

ing it down finer. Theee machines are fitted with electric stop motion. one strand of the sliver breaks the machine will stop and prevent the work being botched. 


