This skirt falls in about the feet so that it has almost the nir of trousers. A deep yoke reveals transparent white tulle that makes a good background for the necklaces worn. The shape of the hat and the pose of the aigrette are. like the whole costume, reminiscent of the costume of the Russian ballet.

On lines culled from gowns of the last century are some of the other costumes. For instance, the little white taffeta e sque coat worn with a white mousseline do soie robe. This casque is charmingly e abroidered with bright colored sprays. A few folds of the skirt are caught up in front by a beaded cord and tassel. 
