The firemen succeeded in subduing the flames with one line of hose. The alarm was sent in from Box 32, at the corner of Colborne and Main streets.

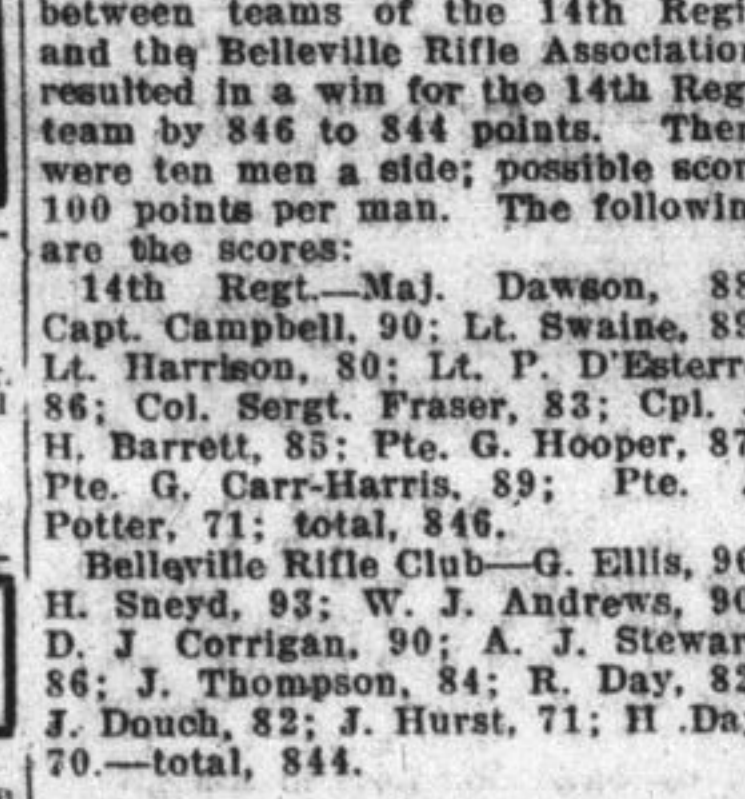
