London, April 2.—The treasury statement for the fiscal year seems to justify the most criticized optimism of David Lloyd George, chancellor of the exchequer, which led him a year ago, to decide to meet the heavy increase in expenditures by a natural growth of revenue from the existing taxes instead of imposing new taxes.

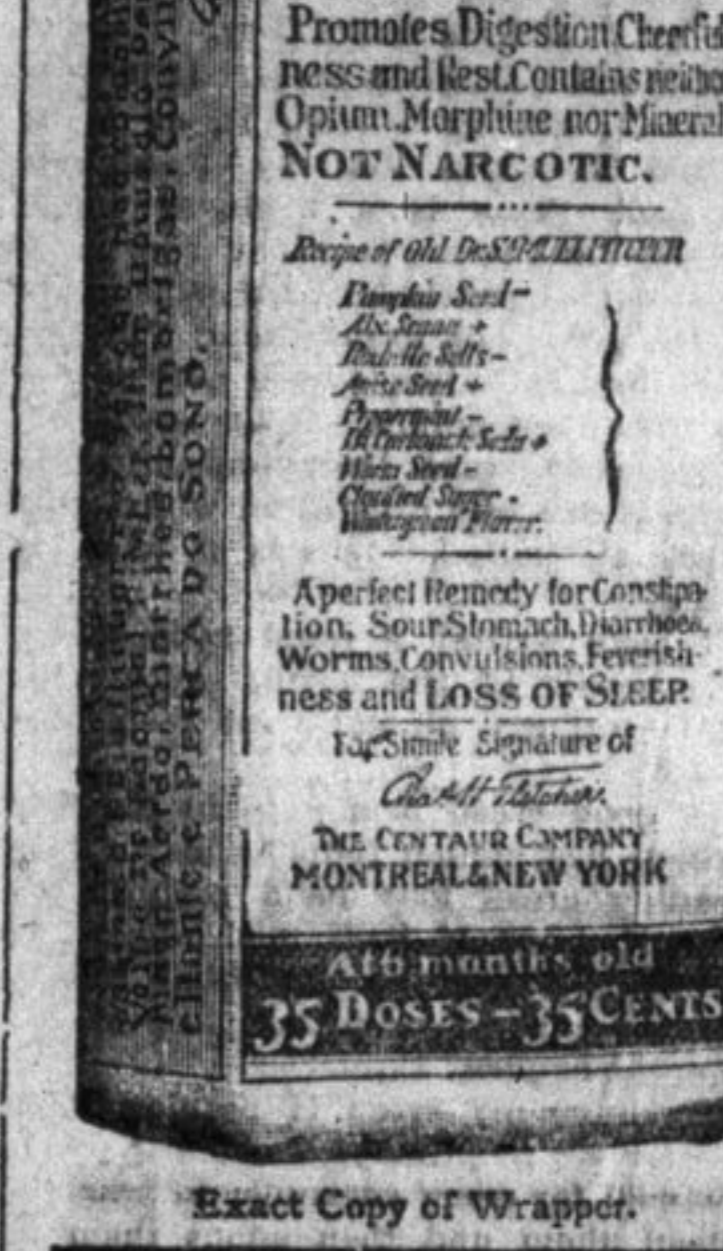
