Can you realize the importance of the fact that not one person was actually cured of a clearly established and real cancer by the radio-therapists?

"Here is a case in a medical publication, illustrating the radio-therapists' methods. They say they cured a young woman of genuine cancer and have the audacity to state that the fact of the cure of the cancerous growth was established at autopsy-for, of course, the died. That is the radium-cured can-

"Or consider the case of the American Congressman, R. G. Bremner, suffering from an unmistakable cancer. He was treated in a vastly expensive manner by radium. Mr. Bremner died, as all patients so treated must die, and/I am prepared to challenge contradiction.

"I am willing to go so far as state, that a physician, continuing to employ radium for a long period, is either abusing public confidence or is culpably ignorant. I am willing to state that the majority of such pyhsicians are nothing but charlatansfunctionaries employed by persons or societies desirous of making sordid financial gains from the exploitation

of radium. "I have been overwhelmed by offers to sell radium from interested intermediaries. My colleague, Prof. Modlinsky, of Moscow, had not been in Berlin one day before he was besieged by persons anxious to negotiate the sale of mesothorium, a radio-

active substance. an infernal fraud, operated by ignorant or dishonest persons, and causing incalculable harm to the suffering-it is also the most cruel of frauds owing to the hopes is raises in persons doomfed to ultimate death. "Cancer sufferers, however, need not despair utterly. A system of electro-thermic treatment of cancer, combined with surgical extirpation by a competent operator, has produced genuine cures.

"I can demonstrate the success of the system, which is called electric coagulation, from the fact that canderous cells coagulate under the influence of electric heat just as the white of an egg coagulates when heated, by producing cured patients with a full history of their cases and explicit details.

"I can produce many such, but lefy the radio-therapists to produce

"As regards the American radiotherapists I can make no statement from direct personal knowledge; but my opinion of the futility of radium must apply equally to them.

"I think it a fact that Americans are accustomed to do innumerable stupid things for the sake of a new thing, but time will teach them wisdom and justify my words."


