FORMERLY LIVED HERE

He Lived in Kingston For Twenty Years - Since 1881 He Lived in Brooklyn - Leaves a Large Estate.

Kingston people who remember John A. Moody, the dry goods merchant who, from 1881 to 1881, lived on Princess street, will be sorry to learn of his death at Brooklyn, N.Y.

Mr. Moody, from heart trouble, passed away at his late home, No. 256 Adelphi street, on Friday morning, and was laid to rest on Monday afternoon in the Calvary cemetery.

At eleven o'clock on Monday morning the body, accompanied by the members of his family and scores of friends, was taken to the St. John's chapel, Green and Clermont avenues, Brooklyn, where a requiem mass was offered, and then the relatives and friends, in fifty carriages, accompanied the remains to the cemetery.
