DEALT WITH BY REV. J. W. McINTOSH ON SUNDAY.

The Awfulness of Being Separated From God and Making a Shipwreck of Life.

The loss of the steamer Empress of Ireland, with its crowd of passengers, is a tremendous and awful loss, but infinitely worse than the loss of this steamer...

These spoke Rev. J. W. McIntosh, pastor of Cooke's church, during the course of his Sunday morning sermon. He was speaking on the subject, "The Great Shipwreck," and chose his text from 1 Timothy 1, 19:

"Holding faith, and a good conscience which some have away concerning faith have made shipwreck."

The words of the text were the words of a missionary to a young leader, and they gave out a warning. We often heard about a shipwreck but did not realize what it implied.

"I would have been awful to have been associated with such an experience which came to the passengers of the steamer Empress of Ireland, but it would have been infinitely more awful to be in danger of spiritual shipwreck."

View of English Experts—Swiftness of Blow Left no Time to Use Any Elaborate Appliances for Life-Saving

London, June 1.—It seems the pretty general consensus of opinion among the experts and the general public that nothing was lacking in the equipment of the Empress of Ireland, as the Times says, "The frightful suddenness and swiftness of the blow left no time for the use of the elaborate appliances and arrangements for the saving of life with which the ship was fitted."

Naturally, those who always seem critical of the St. Lawrence navigation from the insurance viewpoint, use the disaster as a fresh illustration of the risks.

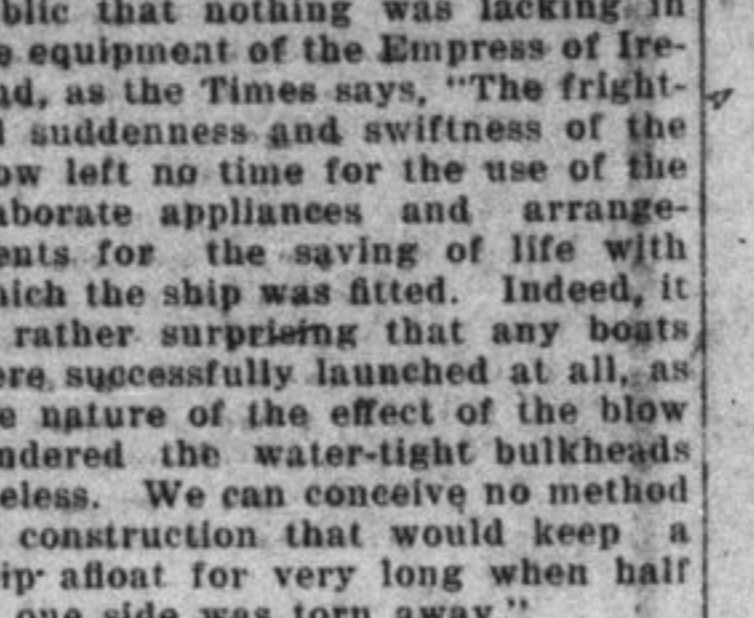

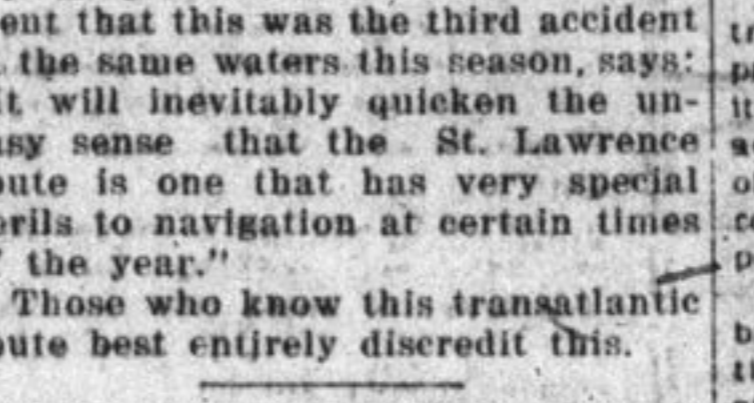
