Trustee R. Meek made this statement regarding "technical education" the Board of Education on Thursday evening...

During my recent visit to the west I had an occasional hour which was spent in a visitation of the public and high schools...

What I learned during my investigation was this: That the substantial progress of the pupils in technical work was of great benefit to them when they left school...

With regard to domestic science in the institute, the principal contention is that without it technical education cannot be successfully carried on; that there must be work for the girls as well as the boys when they are separated from their classes and for practical instruction...

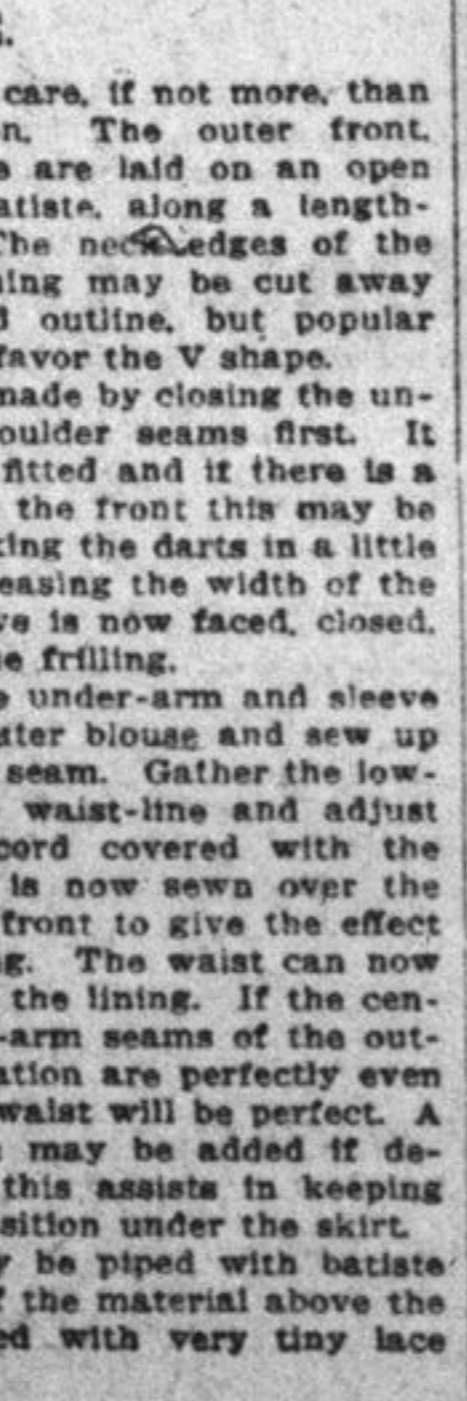

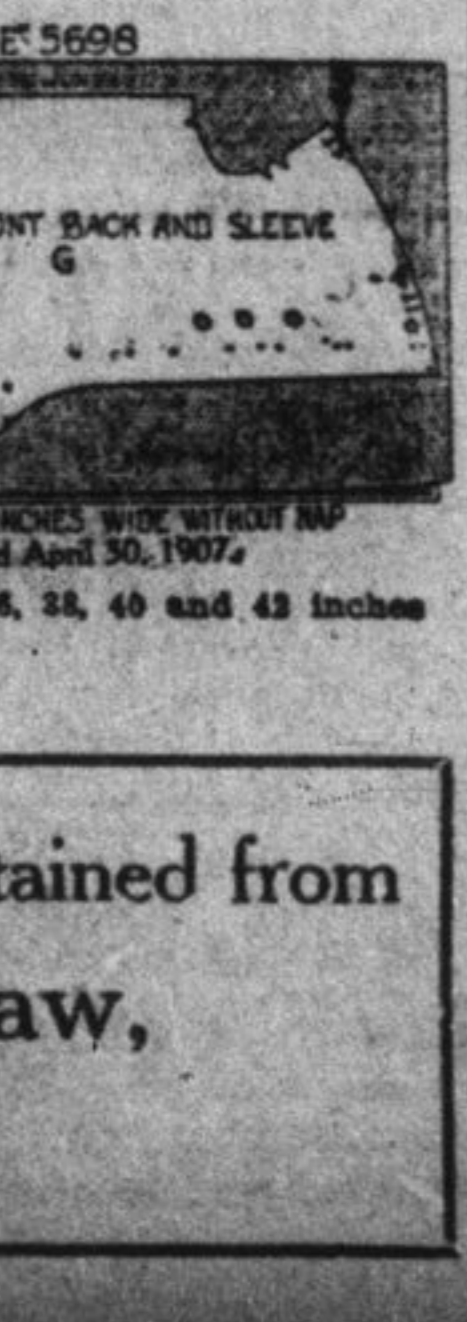
