Nutmeg Poison. A German medical journal, the Munich Medizinische Wochenschrift, gives a curious story of a case of poisoning from nutmeg, an article in daily use in food and drink. Two servant girls partook of a mixture made up of two ground nutmegs, a small quantity of powdered cinnamon, and half a litre about one pint, of hot wine. One girl, the greater part of the other, but a small portion. Both were taken to the hospital-unconscious. The one who drank the greater part remained in a stupor for three days, and it was not until the fifth day that she recovered her senses. The other, who, like the first, developed failure of memory, vertigo and somnolence, was not so long in recovery. Nutmeg contains an ethereal oil that is a recognized poison.
