TURKS WERE TO KILL

MAJ.-GEN. SAM HUGHES, MINISTER OF MILITIA.

London, Ont., Police Found Letter Proving Guilt—The Turks Are Now In Fort Henry.

Letters found in the possession of the prisoners and interpreted by a government secret service man, are claimed to be a direct indication that an attempt was to have been made on the life of General Hughes when in the city to-day.

This reference, say the police, is to General Hughes' visit. Another letter, turned over to the military authorities at Ottawa, and the contents of which the police will not divulge, is said to have contained information that definitely assigned the Turks to the assassination of General Hughes.

OVER FOUR HUNDRED The Military Prisoners Are Kept Well Do No Work.

There are now 409 suspects in Fort Henry, 114 of them being Turks. Most of the Turks are from Brantford, where they have been working in the factories there.

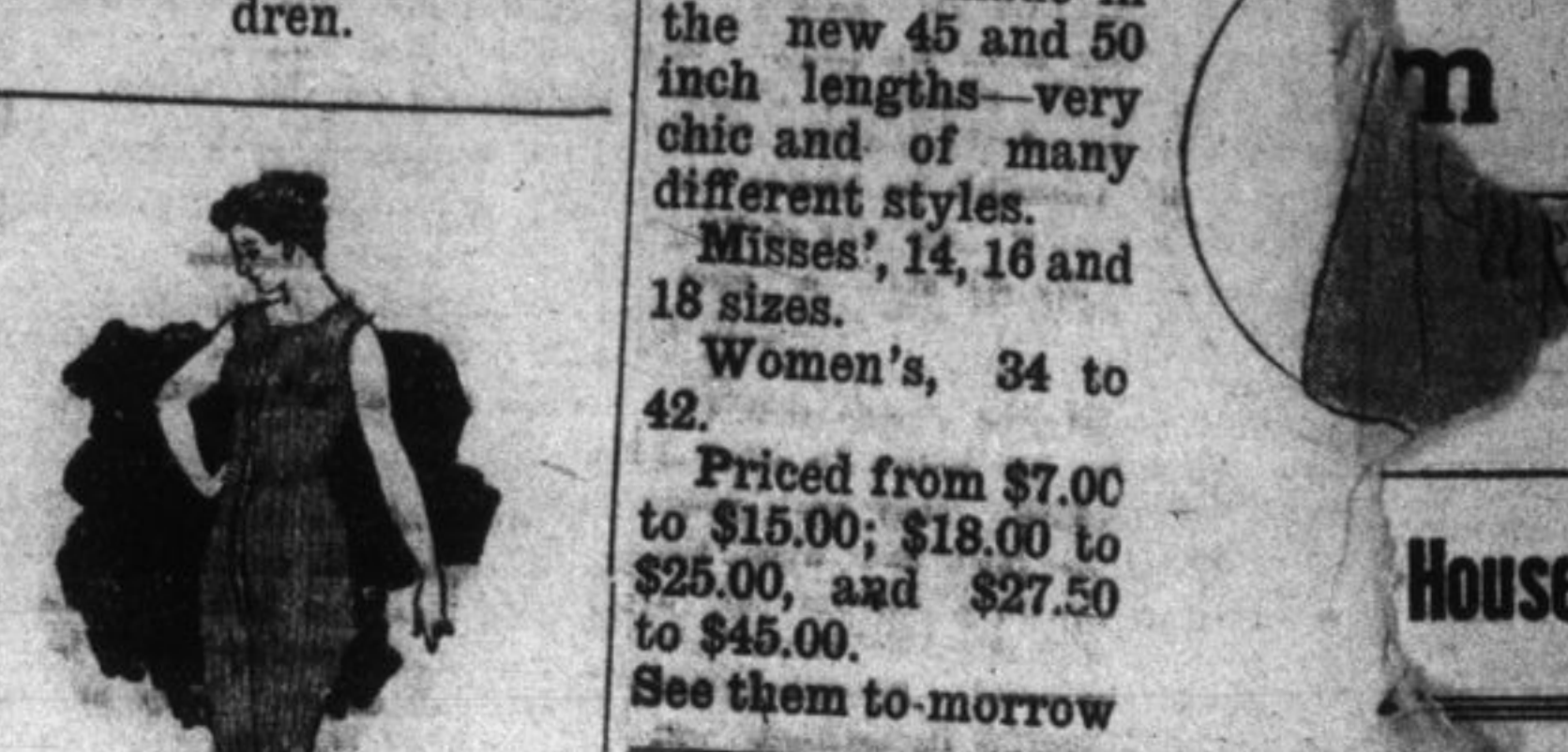
