TURKS EXPELLED JEWS

DROVE ABOARD SHIP UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES OF BARBARITY

Threw Men Into Sea- Those Who Objected to Abuse of Wives Were Hurled Overboard.

Chicago, Dec. 24 .- The expulsion of Jews from Jara was accompanied by many acts of barbarism and robbery, according to a special cablegram from Cairo, Egypt, to the Chicago Daily News. The story says that 600 refugee Jews from Java have just 'arrived at Alexandria on the Italian steamer Xincenio Florio, and

"Thursday afternoon Bedouin police raided the Ghetto (at Jaffa), arrest ed 1,600 prisoners, and drove the at the point of the bayonet to the quay. Here the Florio was forced to as many as could be crowded aboard. Scenes attending this operation were heartrending. It was after nightfall, and harbor police and boatmen stole all the watches money the refugees were carrying to the ship. They tore rings from the fingers and even ear-rings from ears of women and girls, and harbor rang with shricks and fran-tic pleas. Children were separated from parents and husbands from

"Several of the men, resenting the brutalities to their wives, were thrown overboard by boatmen and drowned before the eyes of the wo-

"The old Hotel Metropole at Alexandria, and other hotels have been hired for the refugees by several wealthy Jews of all nationalities. Many of the refugees are nearly mad with apprehension for the fate of thousands of relatives and friends, for whom there was no room aboard the Florio. It is feared that this is only the beginning of Turkish atrocities. There are 25,000 or more peaceful Russian Jews inlestine."
