VALUE OF SPRAYING

DEMONSTRATIONS HELD IN VARIOUS PARTS OF FRONTENAC.

Splendid Results Followed the Work in Orchards and in Potato Fields—To Eradicate Mustard Through Spraying.

C. C. Main, the agricultural representative for Frontenac has written the following valuable article on spraying and the splendid result that accrued therefrom:

Although Frontenac county is not especially adapted for fruit growing, yet we find a large number of orchards in the county, some of considerable area, which would be greatly improved by being properly pruned and sprayed.

The second spray was applied just before the buds burst, and a third spraying, on Rutledge Bros., only when 90 per cent of the blossoms had fallen. The total cost of pruning and spraying Rutledge Bros. orchard was \$45.00 and E. Day's orchard, \$37.50.

His orchard did not suffer from the depredations of the caterpillars this year, and the foliage on the trees was in an exceptionally healthy condition, while neighboring orchards were stripped by this pest.

Two potato fields were selected for the purpose of demonstrating the value of spraying with Bordeaux Mixture as a preventative against potato blight.

STORIES OF FLAGS

ORIGINS OF SOME OF EMBLEMS OF NATIONS.

Tricolor of Belgium. Was Originally the Standard of the Duchy of Brabant—Complex Colors of Austria and the Flags of Germany, France, England and Russia.

Prior to the Franco-Prussian war of 1870 the German empire was little more than a group of scattered states. When they combined into a single empire, however, traces of all their flags were combined in the resultant standard.

To be sure, the colors of Prussia—black and white—and the Prussian eagle enter very largely into it, but it must be remembered that this country became at that time the head and ruler of all the others.

The flag of Austria is a very complex affair. To begin with, the various Austrian provinces have their own flags. Bohemia is red-white, Tyrol is white-red, Dalmatia is blue-yellow, Galicia is blue-red, Croatia is red-white-blue and Istria is yellow-blue.

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The Imperial standard of the czar of all the Russians is of brilliant yellow, in the centre of which is a large double-headed black eagle.

The flag of Belgium is composed of a tricolor—black, yellow and red—equal in width and height.
