SERVICE. A VALET'S BRAVE ACT

In Saving The Life Of Earl of Dalhousie.

The valet mentioned in the following which is clipped from an old country paper, is a younger brother of Alexander Tait of Bloomfield, and John Tait of Picton:

"A Rosecommon telegram says that the Earl of Dalhousie, lieutenant in the Coldstream Guards, who was recently wounded, probably owes his life to the devotion of his valet, who accompanied him on active service in France.

The brave act of young Tait will no doubt be suitably acknowledged had he been in the colors his bravery would have won for him the Victoria Cross.

The Edinburgh Weekly News prints a picture of G. H. Tait, the hero referred to above and the following interesting account of his experiences is quoted from a letter written by him to the members of the British Artisan Golf Club and published in the News:

"The earl was with the army corps that defended Ypres until reinforcements arrived. There were 30,000 against 20,000," it says.
