READY FOR THE ORDER

TO EMBARK AND PROCEED TO THE FRONT.

The 21st Battalion and the 22nd Battery are now in good condition—Deseronto to say good-bye to Lieut.-Col. Rathbun.

The 22nd Battery is rapidly getting into shape and making itself ready for the firing line. The gunners have been thoroughly instructed in the use of the guns, and on Thursday at their first practice at using shells showed their efficiency in quick movements.

The 21st Battalion is now ready for the expected call to leave for the front, and the division can well be proud of the men being sent on the second Canadian Expeditionary Force. Although all of the 1,100 men in the battalion did not come from this district, the great majority of them did, and it is now the finest battalion in Canada.

When this body of men first came in the city five months ago, a large number were constantly being brought before the O. C. for being drunk, but these fellows have been gradually struck off the strength and convictions now are few. The order has been in force for some time that any soldier who is brought up for drunkenness is to be given a 14-day confinement, and this has been strictly enforced.

Arrangements have been made in Deseronto for a public reception and address to be given on Saturday night to Lieut.-Col. R. W. Rathbun before his departure with the second overseas contingent.

Lieut. J. F. Gilmore, former officer of the Governor-General's Foot Guards, Ottawa, has been attached to the 21st Battalion, C.E.F., Kingston.

Prof. L. W. Gill gave an illustrated address in the militia Y. M. C. A. Hall on Thursday evening on the subject, "Aeroplane and Their Place in Warfare." The speaker dealt principally with the construction and advantages of the aeroplane, rather than the airships of the Zeppelin type.

GOOD AND HARD BY THE WAR TAX IMPOSITIONS.

The war tax increases announced by the Canadian minister of finance will affect the wholesale manufacturing firm of N. C. Polson & Co., Kingston, very materially. The firm's business extends all over the world.

The announcement of a tax on proprietary medicines means that the firm's business will be at a standstill until the full details are announced, for further sales cannot be made under present conditions and at the old price.

The war tax on telegraph messages will likely be collected by the state of special stamps. These stamps will be sold at every telegraph office and the agent will be responsible that every message received will have one of the stamps affixed to it.

The new war tax was felt in the city on Friday morning when a draft was presented to a Princess street merchant bearing the stamps calling for a collection of fees.
