LIVE STOCK MARKETS.

The Prices Paid At The Various Centres.

Toronto, March 15.—There was a heavy run of cattle at the Union Stock Yards this morning, which proved too much for trade, and prices were down from 10 to 20 cents.

Montreal Live Stock.—Trade at the West End Market to-day was good, with a slight decline in the prices all round.

Buffalo Live Stock.—East Buffalo, March 15.—Cattle receipts, 5,000 head; slow. Prime steers \$8.50 and \$8.60; shipping, \$7.50 and \$8.25; butchers, \$5.75 and \$7.75; heifers, \$5 and \$7.50; cows, \$2.50 and \$6.50; bulls, \$4.50 and \$6.75.

Chicago Live Stock.—Chicago, March 15.—Cattle—Receipts 15,000; market strong; native, \$5.80 to \$8.85; Western steers, \$5 to \$7.45; cows and heifers, \$3.40 to \$7.70; calves, \$6.50 to \$10.

Expenditure On Hudson Bay R. R.—Ottawa, March 18.—The Minister of Railways and Canals, Hon. Frank Cochrane, stated that \$7,647,197 had been spent to date on the Hudson Bay Railway, which was estimated to cost altogether \$18,000,000.

At Halifax, N.S., J. W. Hatherly, commander of the Allan liner Mongolian, was killed, and Mr. Turnbull, foreman at the drydock, narrowly missed a similar fate as the result of an accident on board the Mongolian, in drydock undergoing repairs.
