ASLEEP IN A STABLE

AND SHOWED FIGHT WHEN PLACED UNDER ARREST.

Two Strangers Objected Strongly To a Visit From Constables—Soldiers Offered Services To the Police.

It is not a pleasant thing to be rudely awakened from a good sound sleep, so it is not to be wondered at that two men, who were in dreamland in James Swift's stables on William street, showed fight when they were disturbed by the police early on Friday afternoon.

Both men are strangers in the city. They had been drinking heavily all morning, and went to the stables uninvited, made themselves right at home, and were soon sound asleep. When a couple of the men in charge of the stables put in an appearance they ordered the strangers to leave, but the men paid no attention to the stable staff. They merely turned over in the hay and went to sleep again. This a call was sent to the police station. Constables Timmerman and Naylor responded, and when they reached the stables the two "troubled" were pounding their ears at a great rate. They made a big fuss when told that the stables were not to be used as a free lodging house. One of the men threatened to assault Constable Timmerman, but when they reached the member of the police force talked Dutch to him for a few minutes and soon brought him to time. Constable Naylor had the other fellow well in hand, and down to the station the two were brought in spite of their loud protests.

A couple of soldiers who noticed that the drunken men were giving the police constables all the trouble they possibly could, came to the assistance of the constables. The soldiers are members of the 21st Battalion.

One of the men is a Scotchman, and he was given some assistance on Thursday night by W. H. Wyllie, Inspector for the Children's Aid Society. He claimed he did not have the price of a meal, and the inspector, who could not see a Scotchman go hungry, provided him with the price. The man spent the night in the police cells. Evidently he had a few shillings put away for Scotch whisky. The two will come before the magistrate Saturday.
