POLITICS ARE TABOOED

IN BRITAIN UNTIL THE WAR IS FINISHED

Unionist Leaders Explain Why They Consented To Join the Asquith Coalition Cabinet.

London, May 27.—The Marquis of Lansdowne and Andrew Bonar Law, both of whom now occupy seats in the coalition Ministry, explained to their followers at a meeting of Unionist members of both House of Parliament held at the Carlton Hotel yesterday the reasons which decided them to join the coalition Parliament.

Lord Lansdowne's Speech. Lord Lansdowne, in opening the meeting, said that ordinarily he disliked coalition governments, but the conditions at present were extraordinary.

Election A Disaster. Lord Lansdowne explained that the Unionist leaders considered that a general election would have been a national disaster of the first magnitude.

Pretender Rainsull's Agitation. Paris, May 27.—Official information from Morocco indicates that Rainsull, the Moorish brigand and pretender to Morocco's throne, is conducting an agitation among the tribes in the district of Ghazal.

General Lyantey, resident French Governor of Morocco, dispatched a detachment of troops against the malcontents. The troops were attacked on May 14th near Boudoums.

Rev. Mr. Christie, Carlton Place, has yielded to the call of the Empire, and will leave for the front next month. His post will be with the Field Ambulance.
