

A GERMAN OPPOSES RUPTURE WITH STATES

Admiral Von Truppel Admits She Could Be Formidable Enemy--Submarine's Limits.

Would This Method of Warfare Force Britain to Kneel He Asks--Must Accept All Consequences of Superiority.

Berlin, July 7, via London.—Admiral Oscar von Truppel, at one time governor of Kiaochau, the German concession in the Chinese Province of Shantung, captured in November by the Japanese, contributes an article to-day to Der Tag, warning his compatriots not to underestimate the danger of a breach with the United States, and asking them to weigh seriously the question whether the value of Germany's submarine warfare against British commerce is great enough to justify a continuance of its present form at the expense of a rupture with the trans-Atlantic nation.

Barry's purchase was prompted not only by desire to obtain the services of the player but a further desire to block Comiskey's attempt to get him for the White Sox.

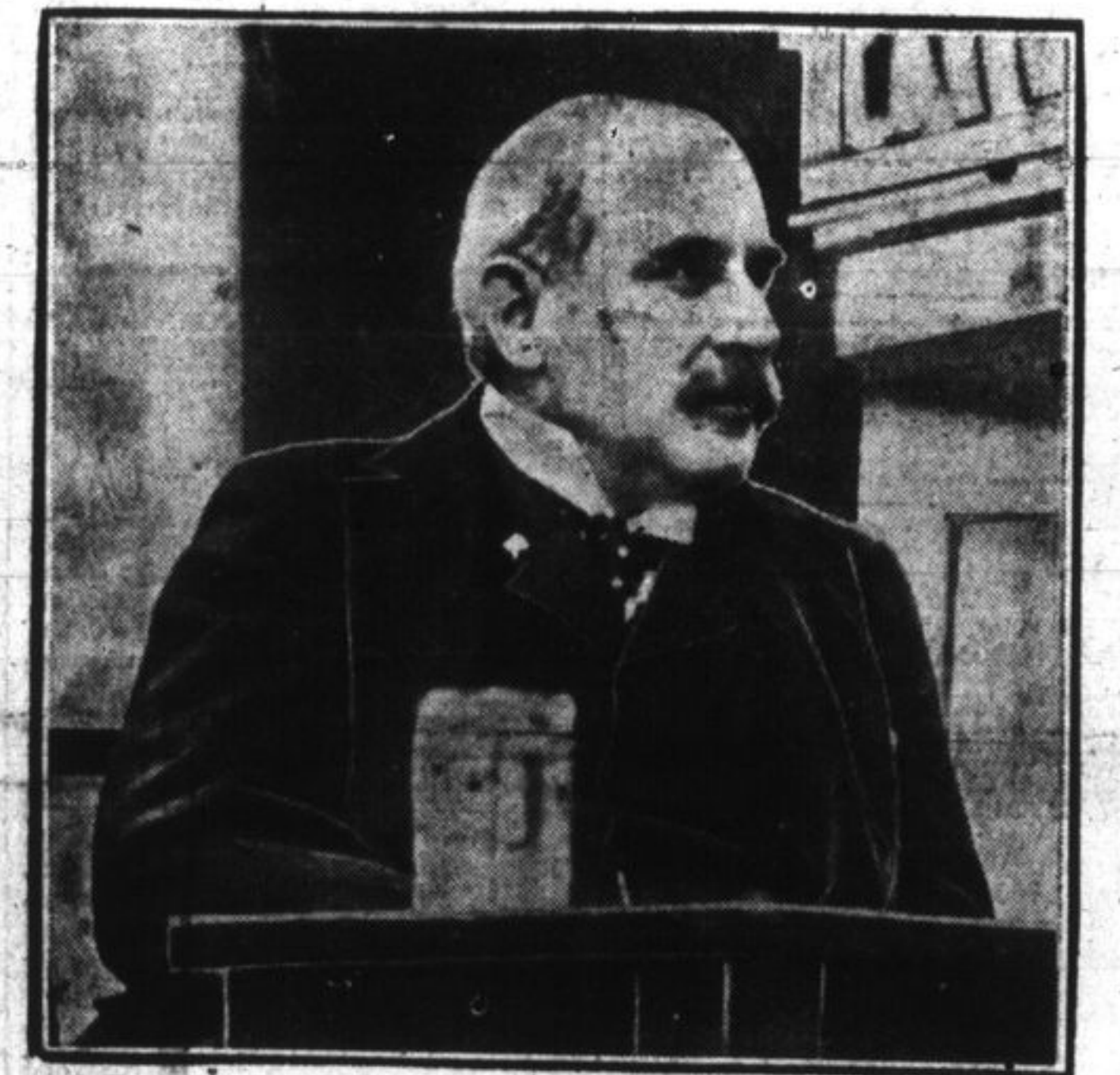
GIVEN THREE MINUTES TO LEAVE SCHOONER

MONEY HAS POURED FREELY INTO FOSTER COMPANIES.

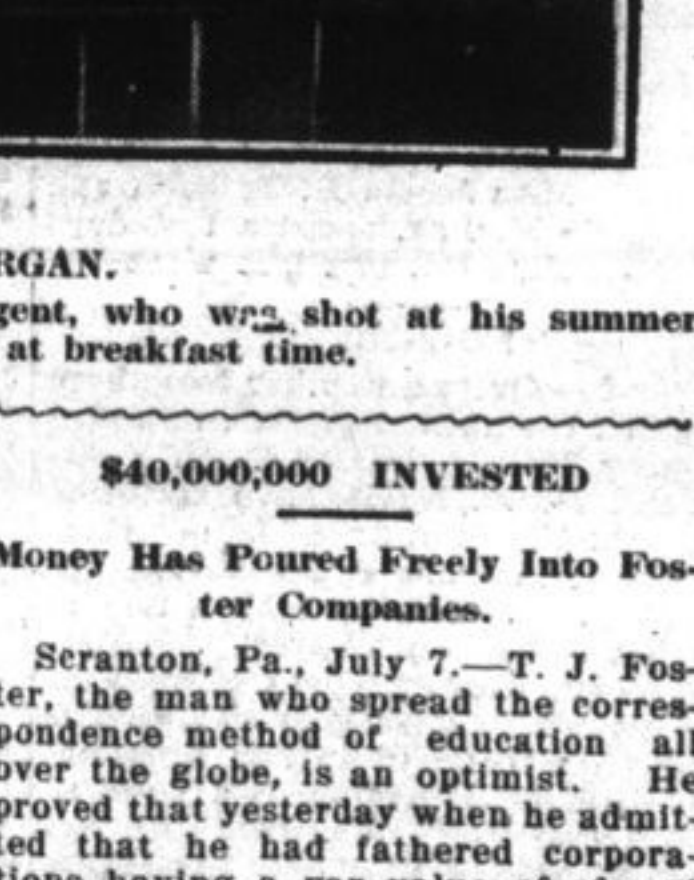
