CONSTABLE WAS SHOT BY THE ACCIDENTAL DISCHARGE OF HIS RIFLE.

Earl Jenkin Had Close Call On Wolfe Island Shore On Friday Afternoon—Tripped On Rocks And Gun Went Off.

As the result of the accidental discharge of a rifle near the Wolfe Island shore, on Friday afternoon, Police Constable Earl Jenkin was shot, in his left wrist.

Constable Jenkin was out with Constable Sargeant and a number of friends on a boating trip. He had his rifle with him and in getting out of the boat he tripped against some rocks and as a result the rifle was discharged, the bullet of 32 calibre, entering his wrist striking the artery, inflicting an ugly wound and then glancing off.

Constable Sargeant rendered first aid and then the injured man was rushed over to the city, where his injuries were dressed by Dr. Robert Hanley.

IN MARINE CIRCLES. The Movements Of Vessels Around Kingston Harbor.
