It was announced at the Utilities Commission meeting on Monday afternoon that the Seymour Power Company, with which the city had dealings some years ago, and which were ended when the Hydro-Electric Commission drew a herring across the trial, to the city's sorrow, would consider an application to supply Kingston with water power.

New York, Nov. 15.—Willy G. Halldorf, who was chief chemist of the Federal Sugar Refinery in Yonkers for many years, and who suffered a delusion last June that Claus A. Spreckels, the president, had designs against his life, became violently insane in the church on Sunday morning after his wife had lost her reason on the moment before, setting the congregation of St. John's Lutheran Church, Yonkers in confusion.

Guaranty Trust Offers Shareholders New Stock At Par. New York, Nov. 15.—The Guaranty Trust Co. of New York has decided to increase its capital from \$10,000,000 to \$20,000,000.
