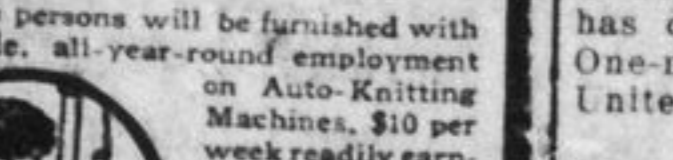

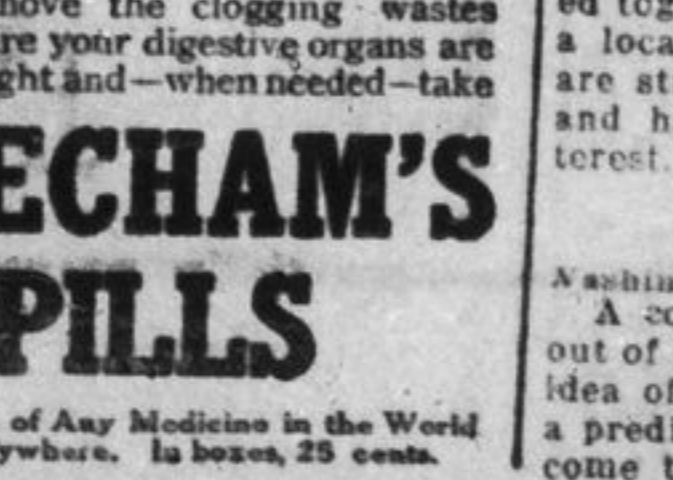

A VISION OF WAR.

The following is an extract from a speech delivered by Col. Ingersoll, the noted orator, to the veterans of the Civil War, at Indianapolis, in 1876. It seems worthy of reproduction at this time:

Again we are in a great struggle for national life. We hear the sounds of preparations—the music of boisterous drums—the silver voices of heroic bugles.
