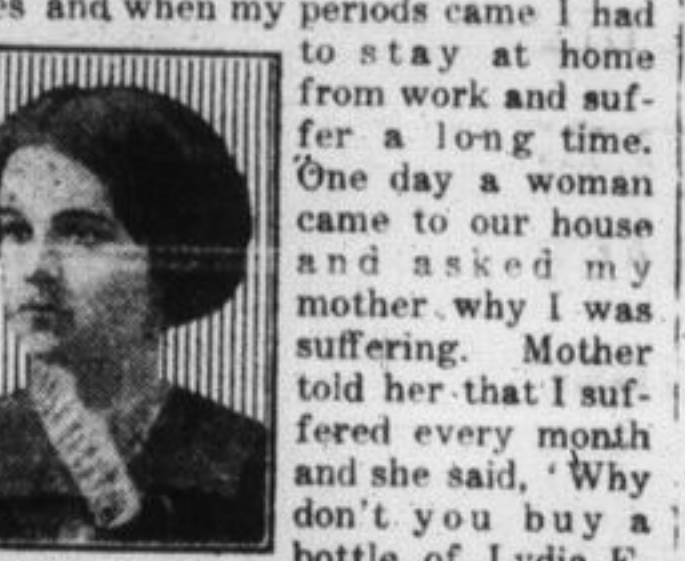

THE OLD NIPIGON LINE

PIONEER RAILWAY HAD A BRIEF AND PICTURESQUE CAREER.

It has served as a line of communication for construction armies of the Canadian Northern and the National Trans-Continental.

TO-DAY some discerning visitor to the old settlement of Red Rock—now called Nipigon—would have his curiosity aroused by a string of ties which drop from the limits of the town, down the face of a lofty and precipitous sandbank, across the Canadian Northern tracks, into the seething waters of the Nipigon River, which run at the rate of some eight miles per hour.

Talk of momentum grades, this needless road can boast of the greatest momentum outside of an incline railway or Swiss funicular.

The explanation is simple. While the Nipigon Forest Reserve is penetrating today by the transcontinental line of the Canadian Northern Railway System, in addition to which the C.P.R. crosses the river at a point where it broadens out into a landlocked arm of Lake Superior, and the N. T. R. touches the far northern shore of Lake Nipigon, there was an earlier railway to reach the heart of that picturesque and interesting region, which flourished, unaided, by the outer world, and is now but a memory perpetuated by several thousands of grass grown spikes and ties.
