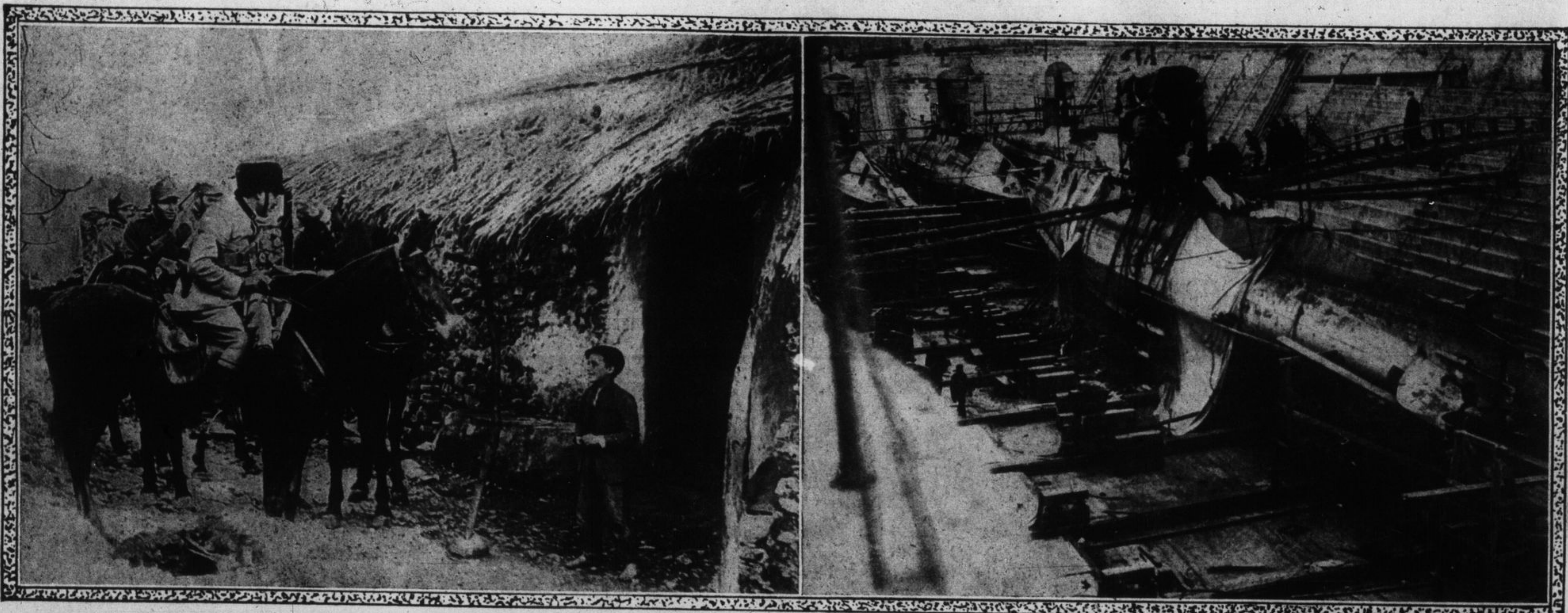


An Arabian family sitting outside their quaint old home in the city of Cairo, Egypt.

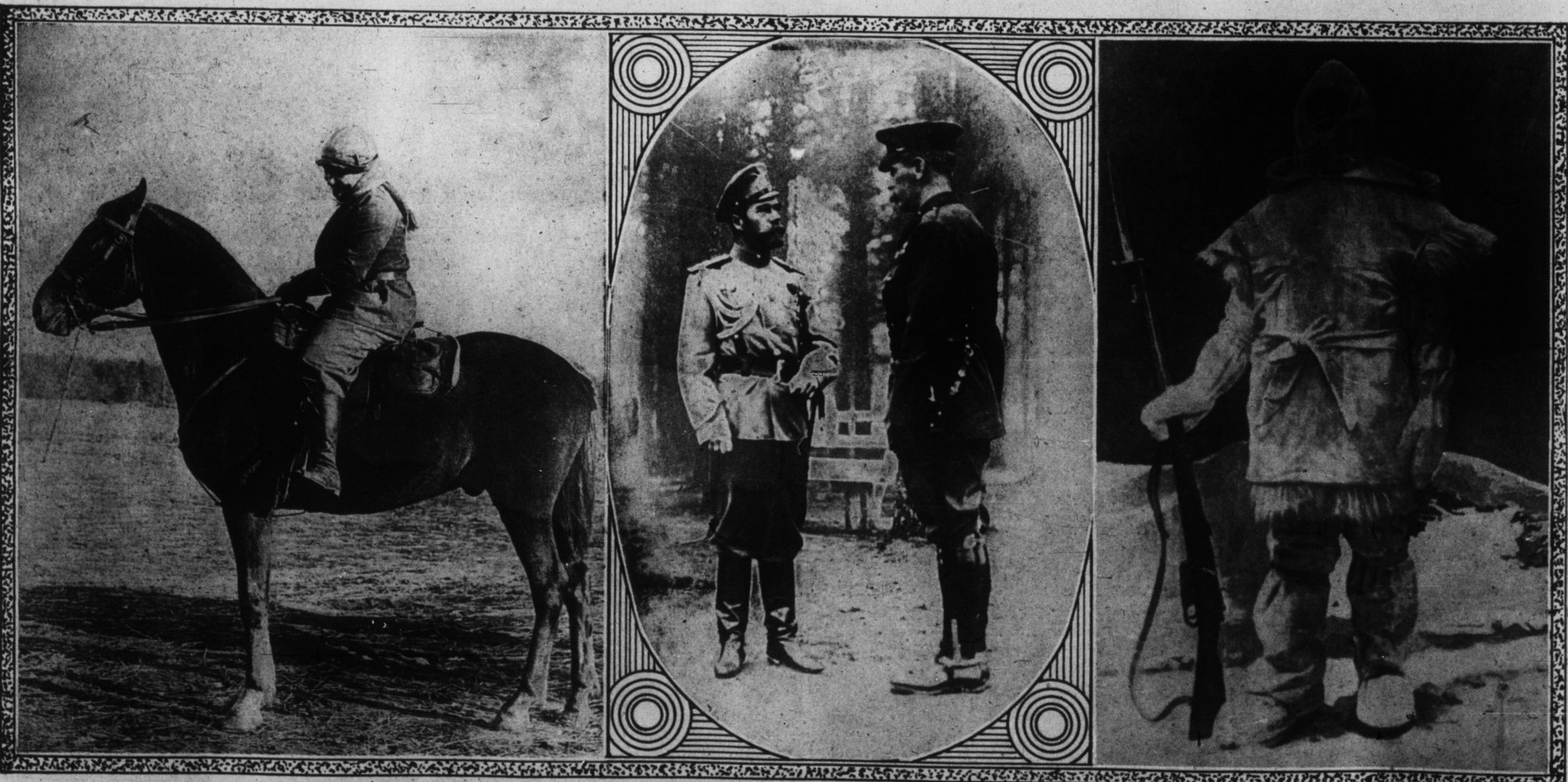
