

At one time from ore was found in considerable quantities in the north. easterly provinces of the Netherlands. In late years apparently less has been found. however, further deposits of iron ore have been found in the province of Drenthe, where it was discovered previously. These deposits were revealed by the digging of peat in the bogs of that section. The ore is found in layers just under the peat, and also in collections or heaps six to ten feet high and thirty to fifty feet in circumference.
