PREPARING PARCELS.
 To Be Sent To Germany For King-ton Prisoners.
 If you were a prisoner of war in a German camp, with no prospects of getting out until the war stopped, how would you like to receive a parcel containing tea, pork and beans, sugar, cocoa, chocolate, tobacco, soap, salt, milk-powder and a can of salmon? These are the contents of the parcels that will be shipped by American Consul F. S. S. Johnson to Germany on Tuesday.
 All day Monday goods for the 125 parcels were arriving at the consulate, and were packed by the consul and his staff. A number of people who have made donations to the fund came in for a few minutes, and were welcomed spectators of the packing. In some cases they also were put to work. It is a big undertaking to prepare 125 parcels so that each will be well enough packed to stand the journey to Germany, but none have arrived there in a damaged condition yet.
