



A TYPE OF VILLA'S FOLLOWERS WHO RAIDED THE TOWN OF COLUMBUS, N.M.

border raids with loss of American lives will stop.






Villa's followers with their families on freight cars moved by "men power" in the absence of other more efficient means of locomotion.




Villaists in the street of a city they have obtained possession of in Mexico.
