Queen's Faculty of Education Must Be Given Increased Accommodation And Larger Equipment.

In a report upon the work of the Faculty of Education at Queen's this session, Dean Coleman states that the total enrollment was 143, as compared with 104 a year ago.

The Dean points out that while the attendance of university graduates may not increase to any material extent in the immediate future, there are large possibilities in the way of an increased attendance of non-graduate students.

Last summer the Faculty offered for the first time classes for candidates for degrees in Pedagogy and also classes for extramural candidates for teachers certificates.

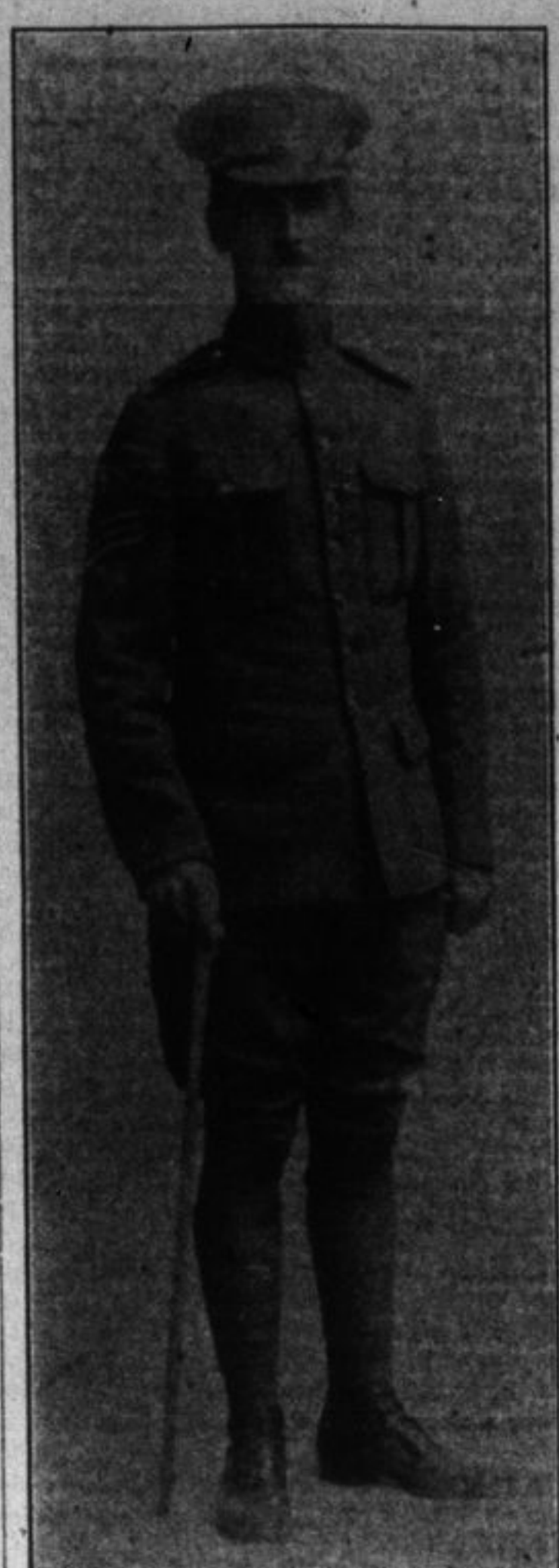

OF THE 21ST BATTALION HAS BEEN WOUNDED.

He Was the First Member of That Unit to Bring Down a German Last Fall.

Miss Bertha Swaine, 158 Frontenac street, received a telegram on Saturday to the effect that her brother, Lieut. Herbert M. Swaine, 21st Battalion, had been wounded at St. Eloi.

When the 21st Battalion was mobilized in Kingston, Herbert Swaine, although a qualified captain in the 14th Regiment, came to the city

from Toronto and enlisted in the ranks of the battalion. He was given the rank of Company Sergeant-Major. Shortly before the battalion left the city he was taken ill but was able to accompany the battalion to England.

When the battalion went into the trenches in France Sergt. Major Swaine had the honor of being the first 21st man to kill a German.

IN MARINE CIRCLES

MANY OLD-TIME VESSELS WILL BE USED ON LAKES

To Meet the Big Demand For Tonnage This Summer—War Will Result in a Scarcity of Men.

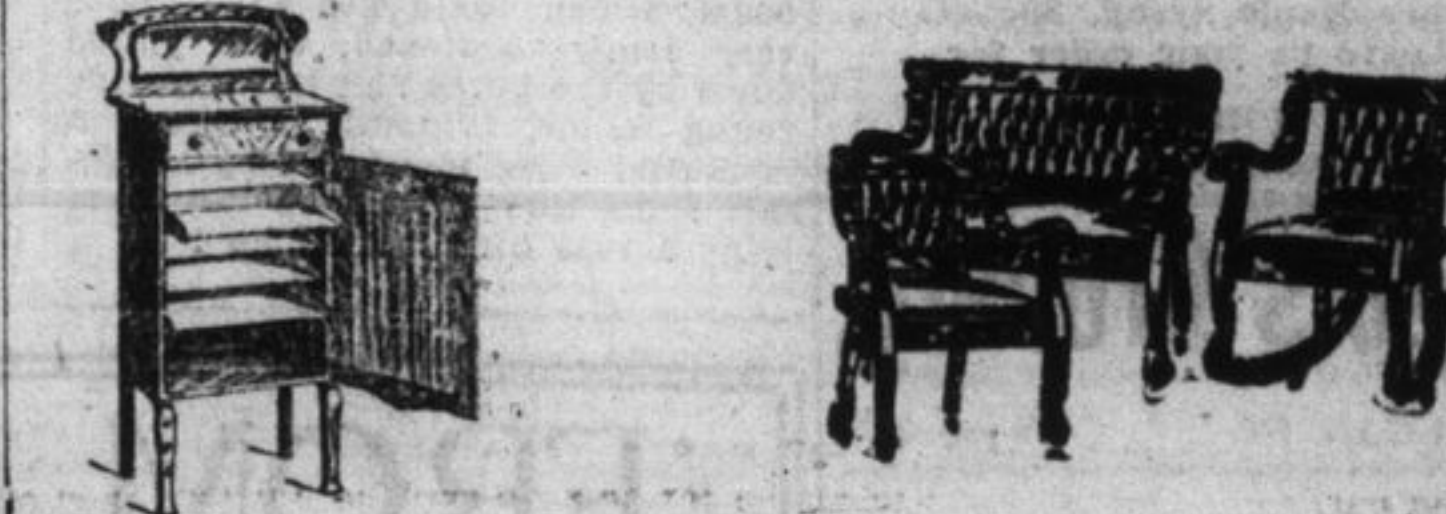
