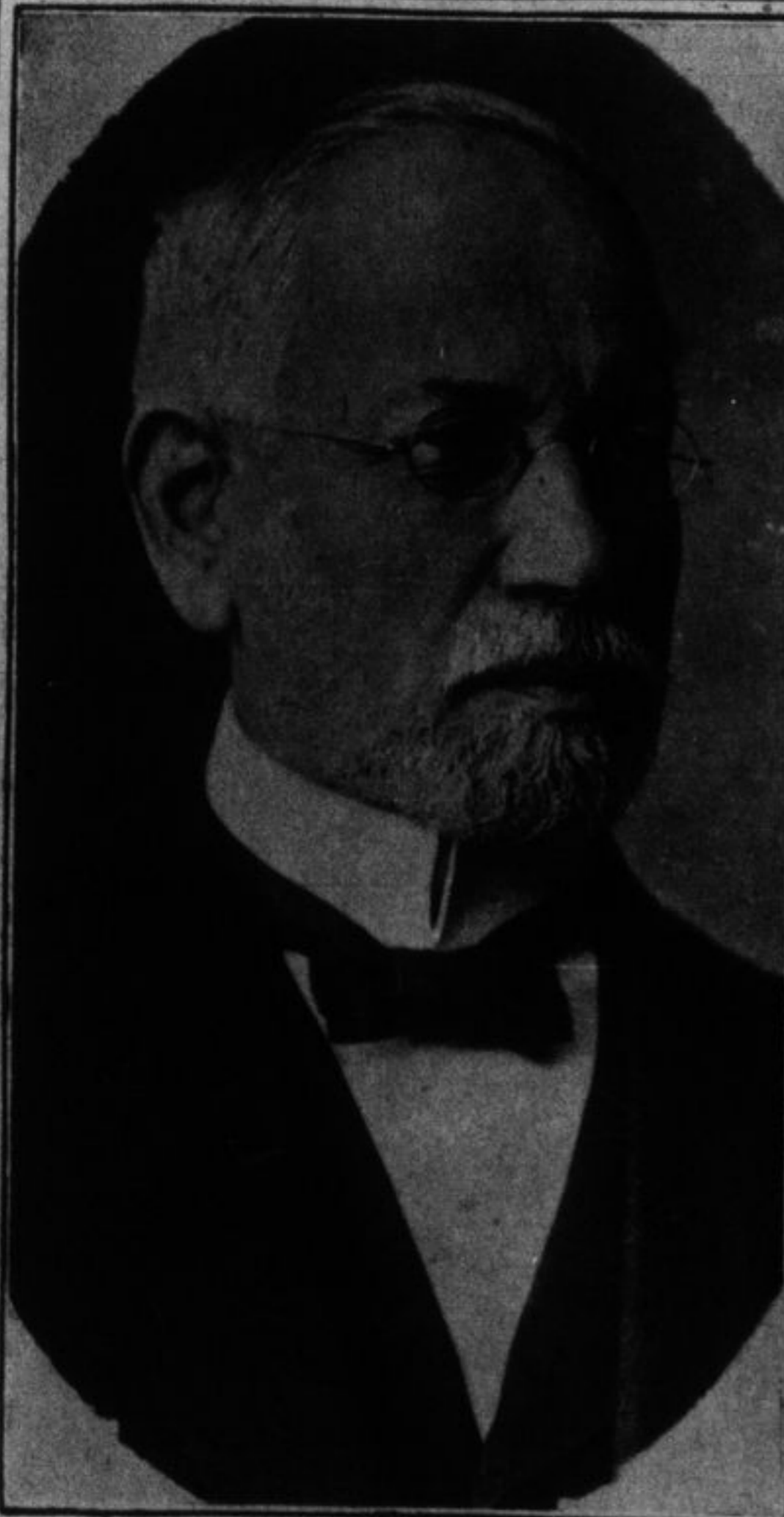

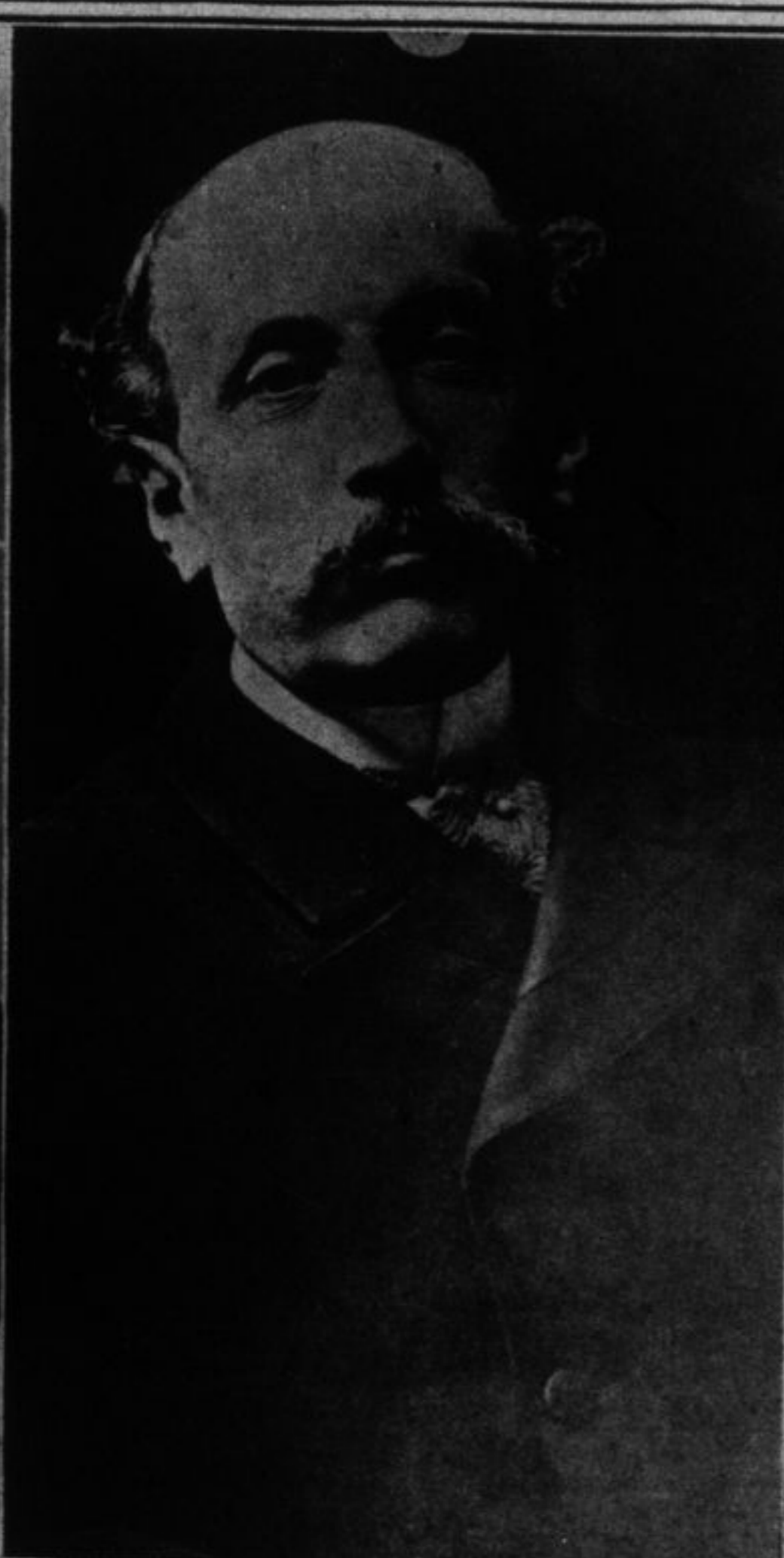

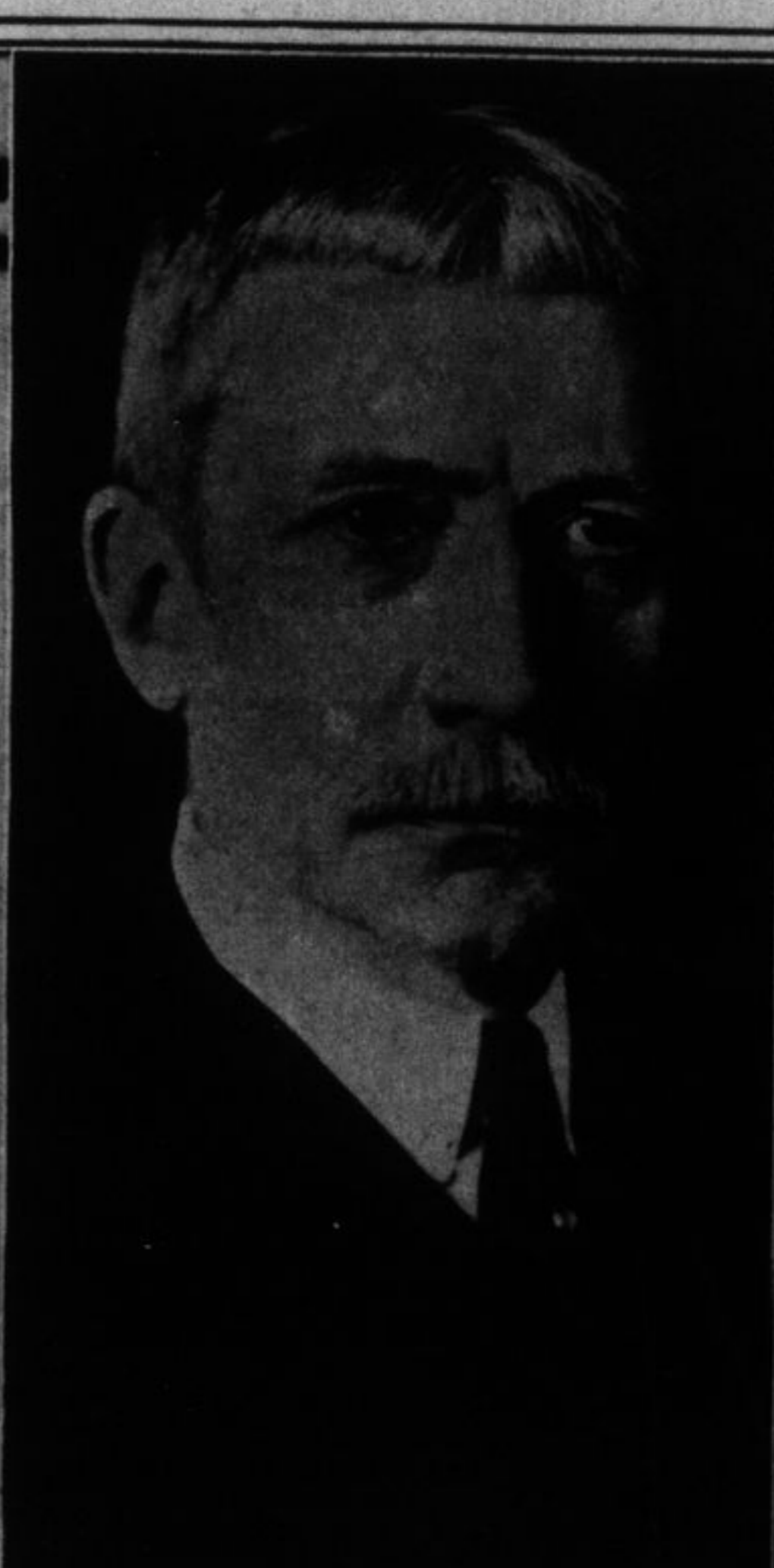
COUNT ROMANONES, SPANISH PREMIER,

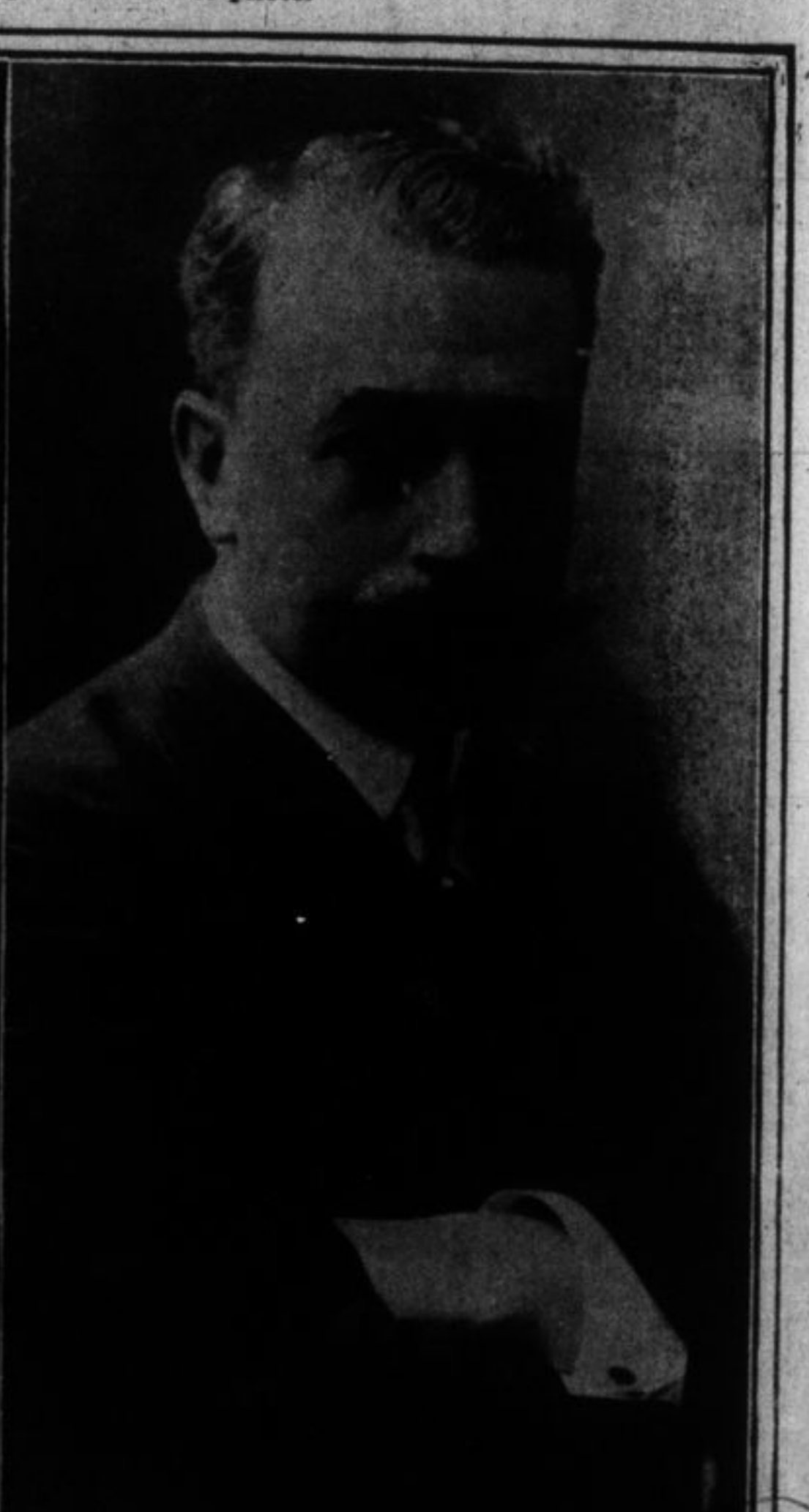
RICHARD HARDING DAVIS,
